COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Assault - 4th Degree - Peace Officer - Throws/transfers bodily fluids or feces at or onto officer

Minnesota Statute: 609.2231.1(c)(2)

Maximum Sentence: 3 years or \$6,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 09/27/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26031131

Charge Description: On or about September 27, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Jasmine Ariana Murphy did intentionally throw or otherwise transfer bodily fluids at or onto a peace officer licensed under state law who was effecting a lawful arrest or executing any other duty imposed by law.

COUNT II

Charge: Assault - 4th Degree - Peace Officer - Physically Assaults

Minnesota Statute: 609.2231.1(b)

Maximum Sentence: 364 days or \$3,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 09/27/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26031131

Charge Description: On or about September 27, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Jasmine Ariana Murphy did physically assault a peace officer when that officer was effecting a lawful arrest or executing any other duty imposed by law.

COUNT III

Charge: Obstruct Legal Process-Interfere w/Peace Officer

Minnesota Statute: 609.50.1(2), with reference to: 609.50.2(2)

Maximum Sentence: 364 days or \$3,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 09/27/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26031131

Charge Description: On or about September 27, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Jasmine Ariana Murphy did, intentionally, obstruct, resist, or interfere with a peace officer while the officer was engaged in the performance of official duties and the act was accompanied by force or violence or the threat thereof.

COUNT IV

Charge: Make Emergency Call-Police/Fire/Medical/Ambulance-No Emergency

Minnesota Statute: 609.78.1(4)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days or \$1,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 09/27/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26031131

Charge Description: On or about September 27, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Jasmine Ariana Murphy did make a call for emergency police, fire, medical, or ambulance service, knowing that no police, fire, or medical emergency existed.

COUNT V

Charge: Trespass-Premises of Another-Refuse to Depart

Minnesota Statute: 609.605.1(b)(3)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days or \$1,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 09/27/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26031131

Charge Description: On or about September 27, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Jasmine Ariana Murphy did trespass on the premises of another and, without claim or right, refused to depart from the premises on demand of the lawful possessor.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On September 27, 2026, Officer Herwig of the Mankato Department of Public Safety was dispatched to a board and lodge on report that an individual would not leave the premise.

Officer Herwig spoke with Witness 1—a manager of the lodge. Witness 1 stated that Jasmine Ariana Murphy (dob 10/20/1995) had been staying at the lodge. Murphy was threatening other individuals. They provided Murphy with a timeframe to leave the lodge. However, Murphy continued threatening individuals. Witness 1 stated they directed Murphy she must now leave the lodge immediately, but she refused to leave.

Officer Herwig went with Witness 1 and spoke with Murphy. Witness 1 explained to Murphy that she was trespassed from the property and must leave. Murphy refused to listen and became agitated. Officer Herwig then explained to Murphy that she was trespassed from the lodge and must leave immediately and not return for 12 months. Officer Herwig provided Murphy with a trespass notice. Murphy grabbed the notice, crumpled into a ball, and threw it on the ground.

Murphy then began screaming vulgar statements at officers calling them “crackers” and the n word. Murphy continued to scream and yell at officers including numerous nonsensical statements. At one point, Murphy grabbed a bottle of pills and threw them at Officer Herwig, striking him in the chest. Murphy then began grabbing other items from a bedstand and throwing them towards Officer Herwig.

Murphy then began calling 911 on multiple occasions. Officers told her to stop calling 911 and hang up the phone. Murphy called again.

Officers attempted to arrest Murphy who physically resisted, including using force. At one point, Murphy spit towards Officer Herwig. Some of the spit landed on Officer Herwig. Sgt. Gagnon sustains injuries based on Murphy’s resistance.

Eventually, officers were able to arrest Murphy. She was taken to the hospital for an evaluation. The hospital cleared Murphy to be confined. She was then transferred to jail.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
