COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Domestic Assault - By Strangulation

Minnesota Statute: 609.2247.2

Maximum Sentence: 3 years or \$5,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 06/08/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26017849

Charge Description: On or about June 8, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Daniel Patrick Parrott did assault a family or household member by strangulation.

COUNT II

Charge: Domestic Assault-GM-Subsequent Violation

Minnesota Statute: 609.2242.2

Maximum Sentence: 364 days or \$3,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 06/08/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26017849

Charge Description: On or about June 8, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Daniel Patrick Parrott, did, against a family or household member, as defined in M.S.A. 518B.01 Subd. 2, intentionally inflicted or attempted to inflict bodily harm upon another and has a previous qualified domestic violence-related offense conviction or an adjudication of delinquency within ten years.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On June 8, 2026, Officers of the Mankato Department of Public Safety were dispatched to Business 1, a bar in downtown Mankato, for a report of a disturbance.

Officers encountered Daniel Patrick Parrott (DOB: 5/10/1991) nearby and noted he matched the description provided by staff at Business 1. Parrott stated he and his girlfriend of 17 years, whom he lives with—Victim 1—were at Business 1 together when they had an altercation.

Officers spoke with Victim 1. She acknowledged an altercation and stated Parrott was very intoxicated and put his hands around her neck.

Officers went to Business 1 to speak to staff and patrons and review footage. Officers spoke with Witness 1, who reported that he heard arguing between Parrott and Victim 1 and saw Parrott with his hands around Victim 1's neck. Witness 1 reported that Parrott appeared to be choking Victim 1 and multiple patrons intervened.

Surveillance footage showed a heated argument between Victim 1 and Parrott. It also showed Parrott grabbing Victim 1's neck with both his hands. It appears he applied pressure while maintaining his grip on her neck. Parrott's thumbs are positioned in the front of her neck and he shakes her head side to side while maintaining his grip on her neck.

Parrott was previously convicted of misdemeanor Domestic Assault in Court File # 81-CR-22-3.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
