The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Drugs - 3rd Degree - Poss. Sch 1 or 2 Narcotic, LSD, MDA, or MDMA in School/Park/Public Housing Zone

Minnesota Statute: 152.023.2(a)(4), with reference to: 152.023.3(a)

Maximum Sentence: 20 years and/or \$250,000.00 or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 07/18/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26022404

Charge Description: On or about July 18, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota Lonnie Reynolds did unlawfully possess any amount of a scheduled I or II narcotic drug or five or more dosage units of lysergic acid diethylamide (LSD), 3,4-methylenedioxy amphetamine, or 3,4-methylenedioxymethamphetamine in a school zone, a park zone, a public housing zone, or a drug treatment facility

COUNT II

Charge: Drugs - 5th Degree - Possess Schedule 1,2,3,4 or paraphernalia residual - Not cannabis/hemp

Minnesota Statute: 152.025.2(a)(1), with reference to: 152.025.4(b)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years or \$10,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 07/18/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26022404

Charge Description: On or about July 18, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Lonnie Roi Reynolds, did unlawfully possess one or more mixtures containing a controlled substance classified in schedule I, II, III, or IV, except cannabis flower, cannabis products, lower-potency hemp edibles, or

hemp-derived consumer products, and the mixture does not include any amount of a controlled substance in a fluid used in a water pipe, and the person possesses more than one dosage unit if the substance is packaged in dosage units.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On July 18, 2026, Officers Kelly Wood and Casillas of the Mankato Department of Public Safety came into contact with Lonnie Reynolds (DOB 7/2/1976) while on foot patrol of the downtown entertainment district. As the Officers passed Jackson Park they observed an unknown male in the park after Park hours. Jackson Park is located in the city of Mankato within the County of Blue Earth. Officers approached the unknown male to address the ordinance violation (violating park hours), and he was identified as Lonnie Reynolds. Reynolds appeared to be passed out in an upright seated position. Officers then woke Reynolds with a verbal alert. Upon talking to Reynolds, it became apparent that he was heavily intoxicated. He displayed slurred speech, heavy swaying while sitting, odor of alcohol, lethargic, confused speech, dazed/glazed eyes. Reynolds was asked to leave and when he stood up to leave the area law enforcement observed Reynolds drop a plastic baggie on the ground. Officers inspected the baggie and it was found to possess a white powdery substance which field tested positive for cocaine a schedule II drug. Reynolds was detained and was cooperative. He admitted to consuming numerous alcoholic beverages. Reynolds provided a Pre-liminary Breath Test which resulted in a .2 Alcohol Content. The substance that Reynolds had dropped was later weighed at .51 grams. Reynolds possessed the narcotics within a protected park/drug zone. Reynolds was later taken into custody but was found to be too intoxicated for jail placement. A warrant is appropriate in this matter.

Reynolds was transported to Brown County Detox on a Hold for Jail.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
