COMPLAINT

Summons

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Liquor-Purchase/Sell/Barter/Furnish/Give to u/21yr

Minnesota Statute: 340A.503.2(1)

Maximum Sentence: up to 364 days in jail and a/or \$3,000 fine

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 07/23/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26023047

Charge Description: On or about July 23, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Carson Derek Holliday did sell, barter, furnish or give alcoholic beverages to a person under 21 years of age.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On July 23, 2026, Sgt. Stephanie Wilkins and Officer Todd Mohr of the Mankato Department of Public Safety were conducting Alcohol Compliance Checks of the businesses that sell alcoholic beverages in the city of Mankato. Officers used a controlled buyer Witness 1 go into Business 1, which is located in the City of Mankato, with in Blue Earth County attempt to purchase an alcoholic beverage.

Witness 1 used her own State of Minnesota driver's license for the attempted purchases. The driver's licenses shows a birthday of 04/27/2007 and lists "UNDER 21 until 04/27/2028" below her photograph.

Witness 1 was provided with a \$20.00 bill as buy money to purchase alcoholic beverages. Witness 1 then entered Business 1. Once inside she was able to purchase an alcoholic beverage. Witness 1 sent a text message to the Officers "Fail" which indicates that she was served an alcoholic beverage. Officers Mohr and Wilkins then entered Business 1 and observed an opened "White Claw" a seltzer canned alcoholic beverage sitting in front of Witness 1 on the bar.

Witness 1 advised that a female employee in a gray collared shirt had served her the beer and not asked for her ID. Witness 1 then left Business 1.

Sgt. Wilkins observed a sole male employee standing behind the bar. Sgt. Wilkins and Officer Mohr made contact with male employee and explained to him that they are law enforcement officers who worked for the Mankato Department of Public Safety. The male employee was identified by his Arizona Driver's license as Carson Derek Holliday (DOB 4/16/2001). He was advised that he had failed the City's alcohol compliance check when he sold Witness 1 the White Claw. Carson stated that he did not ask to see Witness 1's ID.

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
