The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Drugs - 5th Degree - Possess Schedule 1,2,3,4 or paraphernalia residual - Not cannabis/hemp

Minnesota Statute: 152.025.2(a)(1)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years or \$10,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 10/19/2025

Control #(ICR#): 25030161

Charge Description: On or about October 19, 2025, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Derrick Lee Hoehn, did unlawfully possess one or more mixtures containing a controlled substance classified in schedule I, II, III, or IV, except cannabis flower, cannabis products, lower-potency hemp edibles, or hemp-derived consumer products or a residual amount of one or more mixtures of controlled substances contained in drug paraphernalia, and the mixture does not include any amount of a controlled substance in a fluid used in a water pipe and said controlled substance was more than .25 grams or 1 dosage unit

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On October 19, 2025, at approximately 4:59 pm, Commander Sam McGinnis was on a routine patrol when he observed a vehicle on Highway 14 approaching the Southbound ramp for Highway 169. He observed the vehicle bearing Minnesota license plate KNE-422, which was displaying September 2025 registration. A records check confirmed the vehicle's registration was expired. Commander McGinnis then initiated a traffic stop and made contact with the driver who was identified as Derrick Hoehn. A male passenger immediately requested to go inside the store. The passenger displayed signs of nervousness. He was sweating and agitated. Commander McGinnis asked the passenger to identify himself and he provided the name that was later learned not to be his actual name and date of birth. Hoehn was issued a citation for driving behavior and released. The passenger never returned to the vehicle.

Commander McGinnis was able to eventually identify the passenger as Matthew John Grothe and he learned Grothe's driving privileges were revoked and he had an active warrant out of Brown County.

At 5:23 PM, Commander McGinnis observed the same vehicle now being driven by Grothe. A traffic stop was initiated. Commander McGinnis searched the vehicle and discovered a glass bubble pipe and two plastic baggies with a crystalline substance that field tested positive for methamphetamine and weighed over 5 grams. Hoehn admitted ownership of the items. Also found was a second glasses case also containing a used bubble pipe, additional bubble pipe, additional used glass bubble pipes, one gem-style baggie with suspected methamphetamine, and other miscellaneous non-controlled pharmaceuticals.
