The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I**

**Charge: Traffic - DWI - Operate Motor Vehicle Under Influence of Alcohol**

Minnesota Statute: 169A.20.1(1), with reference to: 169A.26.2

Maximum Sentence: 364 days or \$3,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 05/11/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26009923

Charge Description: On or about May 11, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Rebecca Rae Tangen, did drive, operate, or was in physical control of any motor vehicle when she was under the influence of alcohol, and one aggravating factor was present when the violation was committed

**COUNT II**

**Charge: Traffic - DWI - Operate Motor Vehicle Under Influence of Alcohol**

Minnesota Statute: 169A.20.1(1), with reference to: 169A.27.2

Maximum Sentence: 90 days or \$1,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 05/11/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26009923

Charge Description: On or about May 11, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Rebecca Rae Tangen, did, drive, operate, or was in physical control of any motor vehicle when she was under the influence of alcohol.

## STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On May 11, 2026, at 6:53 p.m., Deputy Kowalski of the Blue Earth County Sheriff's Office responded to a motor vehicle crash in Pemberton, Blue Earth County, MN.

He encountered Rebecca Rae Tangen (DOB 07/08/1992). Tangen had been driving a white 2012 Honda Civic bearing: MN 9344AA. While speaking with Tangen, he observed a strong odor of alcoholic beverage. As Deputy Kowalski walked between the vehicles looking at the damage, he observed an empty bottle of whiskey on Tangen's front passenger seat.

Tangen denied consuming alcohol. Deputy Kowalski continued to smell consumed alcoholic beverage and observed her eyes were watery and glossy. He asked Tangen to undergo HGN testing. Tangen completed the tests as instructed. Deputy Kowalski observed all six clues. Due to a pre-existing condition, Deputy Kowalski did not request further field sobriety tests. Deputy Kowalski requested a PBT. Tangen refused.

Deputy Kowalski arrested Tangen and transported her to jail. Deputy Kowalski read the breath-test advisory at 8:51 p.m. Tangen supplied a breath test result of .28. Given the high test, Deputy Kowalski transported Tangen to detox. The State requests a complaint warrant.

## SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:  
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or  
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
