The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

#### **COUNT I**

Charge: Assault - 4th Degree - Peace Officer - Physically Assaults

Minnesota Statute: 609.2231.1(b)

Maximum Sentence: 364 days or \$3,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 05/31/2025

Control #(ICR#): 25015462

Charge Description: On or about May 31, 2025, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Willow Lee Schmidt did physically assault a peace officer when that officer was effecting a lawful arrest or executing any other duty imposed by law.

Charge: Obstruct Legal Process-Interfere w/Peace Officer

Minnesota Statute: 609.50.1(2), with reference to: 609.50.2(2)

Maximum Sentence: 364 days or \$3,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 05/31/2025

Charge Description: On or about May 31, 2025, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Willow Lee Schmidt did, intentionally, obstruct, resist, or interfere with a peace officer while the officer was engaged in the performance of official duties and the act was accompanied by force or violence or the threat thereof.

#### STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On May 31, 2025, at approximately 2:27 AM, officers of the Mankato Department of Public Safety were on patrol in the entertainment district in downtown Mankato, Minnesota, Blue Earth County.

Officer Wagner observed two individuals in a verbal argument. Specifically, one individual later identified as Willow Lee Schmidt, dob 11/20/2003, was yelling at another individual. At one point, Schmidt made a comment about how she was going to slap the other individuals.

Officers decided to intervene. While attempting to intervene, Schmidt put both of her hands and forcefully pushed Officer Wagner. Schmidt was arrested.

(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
