The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I**

**Charge: Drugs - 5th Degree - Possess Schedule 1,2,3,4 or paraphernalia residual - Not cannabis/hemp**

Minnesota Statute: 152.025.2(a)(1), with reference to: 152.025.4(b)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years or \$10,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 03/27/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26009171

Charge Description: On or about March 27, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Jacob Nicholas Vos, did unlawfully possess one or more mixtures containing a controlled substance classified in schedule I, II, III, or IV, except cannabis flower, cannabis products, lower-potency hemp edibles, or hemp-derived consumer products or a residual amount of one or more mixtures of controlled substances contained in drug paraphernalia, and the mixture does not include any amount of a controlled substance in a fluid used in a water pipe and said controlled substance was more than .25 grams or 1 dosage unit or a prior conviction under Chapter 152.

## STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On March 27, 2026, at approximately 7:47 pm, Mankato Police Officers became aware of a driving complaint of a vehicle heading towards Mankato. The 911 caller stated they observed the occupants of the vehicle involved in a physical observation.

Officer Honetschlager conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle that matched the description in Mankato, Blue Earth County, Minnesota. The driver of the vehicle was identified as Jacob Nicholas Vos (dob 2/12/1991). Officers observed a fresh scratch on Vos.

While investigating the physical disturbance, officers observed a syringe that appeared to contain narcotics. Officers also later found a small baggie with a white crystal substance that tested positive for methamphetamine, weighing approximately 2.43 grams, near Vos in the vehicle.

Vos had a prior conviction under Chapter 152.

Vos was transported to New Ulm Detox, for this reason the State is requesting a Warrant.

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:  
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
