The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Traffic - DWI - Refuse to submit to chemical test; Blood or urine as required by search warrant

Minnesota Statute: 169A.20.2(2), with reference to: 169A.25.2

Maximum Sentence:

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 04/21/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26012296

Charge Description: On or about April 21, 2026, in the City of Mankato, County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Daundrea Montreal Anderson, did, drive, operate, or was in physical control of any motor vehicle and the Defendant refused to submit to a chemical test of the person's blood or urine as required by a search warrant and one or more aggravating factors were present when the violation was committed; to-wit: on 07/08/2022, in the State of Illinois, he was issued the equivalent of Minnesota Implied Consent revocation of his driver's license pursuant to a DWI arrest.

COUNT II

Charge: Assault - 4th Degree - Peace Officer - Physically Assaults

Minnesota Statute: 609.2231.1(b)

Maximum Sentence: 364 days or \$3,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 04/21/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26012296

Charge Description: On or about April 21, 2026, in the City of Mankato, County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Daundrea Montreal Anderson did physically assault a peace officer when that officer was effecting a lawful arrest or executing any other duty imposed by law.

COUNT III

Charge: Obstruct Legal Process-Interfere w/Peace Officer

Minnesota Statute: 609.50.1(2)

Maximum Sentence: 364 days or \$3,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 04/21/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26012296

Charge Description: On or about April 21, 2026, in the City of Mankato, County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Daundrea Montreal Anderson did, intentionally, obstruct, resist, or interfere with a peace officer while the officer was engaged in the performance of official duties and the act was accompanied by force or violence or the threat thereof.

COUNT IV

Charge: Traffic - DWI - Operate Motor Vehicle Under Influence of Alcohol

Minnesota Statute: 169A.20.1(1), with reference to: 169A.26.2

Maximum Sentence: 364 days or \$3,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 04/21/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26012296

Charge Description: On or about April 21, 2026 at 10:34 PM, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Daundrea Montreal Anderson, did drive, operate, or was in physical control of any motor vehicle when he/she was under the influence of alcohol, and one aggravating factor was present when the violation was committed; to-wit: on 07/08/2022, in the State of Illinois, he was issued the equivalent of Minnesota's Implied Consent revocation of his driver's license pursuant to a DWI arrest.

COUNT V

Charge: Traffic regulation - Failure to drive in single lane

Minnesota Statute: 169.18.7(1)

Maximum Sentence: \$300 fine

Offense Level: Petty Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 04/21/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26012296

Charge Description: On or about April 21, 2026, in the City of Mankato, County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Daundrea Montreal Anderson, failed to drive his vehicle as nearly as practicable entirely within a single lane of traffic.

COUNT VI

Charge: Wireless Communications Device - Hold wireless communications device with one or both hands

Minnesota Statute: 169.475.2(a)(1)

Maximum Sentence: \$300 fine

Offense Level: Petty Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 04/21/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26012296

Charge Description: On or about April 21, 2026, in the City of Mankato, County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Daundrea Montreal Anderson, while driving a vehicle hold a wireless communication device in one or both of his hands.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On April 21, 2026, at approximately 10:34 pm, Mankato Public Safety Officers were dispatched to a traffic stop. Officer McCarville had initiated a traffic stop and officer back up was requested. Officers Cook, Honetschlager, Christ, and Sgt. Gagnon responded to the request for assistance.

Officer McCarville had initiated a traffic stop after seeing the driver of a black Chevrolet Impala holding his cell phone while driving.

Officer McCarville had been on traffic patrol when he observed a black Chevrolet Impala near Madison/Woodshire not staying within the marked traffic lane. Officer McCarville initiated a Traffic stop on South Riverfront Drive in the City of Mankato, due to also having observed the driver holding a cell phone in his hand while he was driving.

When Officer McCarville identified Daundrea Montreal Anderson, DOB: 06/05/1989, by his driver's license. The music was excessively loud. Anderson began yelling at Officer McCarville. The officer wrote out a citation to Anderson for holding the cell phone in his hand while driving. When handed the citation, Anderson continued to be belligerent, using profane language and making disrespectful comments.

Anderson was given his copy of the citation and released. As Anderson was driving away, he struck the curb as he overcorrected. Officer McCarville initiated another stop of Anderson. Anderson was yelling at the officer, who could smell the odor of consumed alcoholic beverages emanating from Anderson. The officer also noted that Anderson's eyes appeared glossy/watery. Officer Honetschlager arrived on scene and attempted to talk to Anderson.

Officer Honetschlager opened the driver's side door and asked Anderson to step out of the vehicle. Once standing outside the vehicle, Anderson's verbal refusal to comply with officer directives turned into a use of physical force. Anderson pushed at Officer Honetschlager's arm, as he was reaching towards Anderson. Officer Cook then took Anderson's left arm, in an effort to assure officer safety. Officer Cook noted that Anderson tensed his muscles, was verbally combative and Anderson physically attempted to pull his arm from Officer Cook's hold. Officer Cook could smell the odor of alcoholic beverages near Anderson's person. Officers secured Anderson.

Anderson was escorted to a squad vehicle and he continued to push back against the officers guiding him. Sgt. Gagnon was also at the scene and Officer Cook saw Anderson lean into Sgt. Gagnon, as Sgt. Gagnon directed Anderson to "not bite" him. Sgt. Gagnon was bitten by Anderson on his left forearm. Sgt. Gagnon observed blood on his arm, but after washing the site of the bite, his skin was intact, the bite caused a sharp and momentary pain to Sgt. Gagnon and remained red for some time after the incident. As officers attempted to seat Anderson in the back seat of a squad car, Anderson kicked Officer Cook in the torso. Once Anderson was secured in the back seat of the squad car, he continued to kick so hard, that officers noted that the vehicle door rattled and bowed outwards. Anderson also was seen spitting on the partition between the front and back seat of the squad car.

Anderson was brought to the Blue Earth County Jail. Officer McCarville submitted a request for a Search Warrant for blood or urine, which was issued. Officer McCarville showed a copy of the Search Warrant Anderson and explained that if Anderson refused to provide a blood or urine sample, that would itself would be a criminal charge. Anderson continued to yell and refused to provide a blood or a urine sample.

Officer K.C. Baker conducted a search of Anderson's criminal history. Anderson has a number of aliases, but the social security number and photo identifications were also reviewed and Officer Baker determined

that on 07/08/2022, in the State of Illinois, Anderson was issued the equivalent of Minnesota Implied Consent revocation of his driver's license pursuant to a DWI arrest.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
