The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Traffic-DL-Driving after cancellation-inimical to public safety

Minnesota Statute: 171.24.5

Maximum Sentence: 364 days or \$3,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 08/14/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26017077

Charge Description: On or about August 14, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Staci Marie Bergemann did after being given notice, or reasonably should have known of the cancellation, disobeyed the order by operating in this state any motor vehicle, the operation of which requires a driver's license, while her/his license or privilege was canceled; and the Commissioner of the Department of Public Safety has determined that the operation of a motor vehicle on the highways by the person would be inimical to the public safety or welfare.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On August 14, 2026, Deputy Andrew Hagen of the Blue Earth County Sheriff's Office was on standby in Lake Crystal in Blue Earth County when he observed a vehicle being operated by Staci Marie Bergemann (DOB: 04/17/1970). Deputy Hagen was aware from prior interactions that Bergemann's license was cancelled as inimical to public safety under Minn. Stat. § 171.04, Subd. 1(10).

Deputy Hagen witnessed Bergemann drive the vehicle on Main Street and pull out of Business 1 in Lake Crystal. Deputy Hagen pulled Bergemann over and notified her of the reason for the stop. Bergemann told Deputy Hagen that her license was valid but that she did not have any proof or paperwork indicating that she had a valid license.

Deputy Hagen reviewed Bergemann's driving record and found that she had been cancelled inimical to public safety on January 3rd, 2026. Bergemann had a conditional reinstatement on May 22nd, 2026, which was then removed on June 5, 2026, due to failure to maintain the ignition interlock system. Deputy Hagen confirmed Bergemann's license remained cancelled inimical to public safety when she was driving the motor vehicle on August 14, 2026.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
