The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Violate No Contact Order - Within 10 years of the first of two or more convictions

Minnesota Statute: 629.75.2(d)(1), with reference to: 629.75.2(d)

Maximum Sentence: 30 days to 5 years or \$10,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 12/04/2025

Control #(ICR#): 25034732

Charge Description: On or about December 4, 2025 at 5:00 PM, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Surangrat Fox did violate a Domestic Abuse No-Contact Order and the respondent or person to be restrained knew of the existence of the order and the violation within ten years of the first of two or more previous qualified domestic violence-related offense convictions or adjudications of delinquency.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On August 11, 2025, Surangrat Fox (DOB 11/26/1977) was convicted of a Gross Misdemeanor Violation Domestic Abuse No Contact Order (DANCO) in in Blue Earth District Court file 07-CR-25-293. Fox was ordered to have no contact with Protected Party. The DANCO was personally served on Fox the same day. The DANCO includes the following language:

You are ordered to have no contact directly, indirectly or through others, in person, by telephone, in writing, electronically or by any other means with the Protected Person....

You may not go to wherever the Protected Person resides

You are also restrained from harassing, stalking, or threatening the protected person(s) or engaging in other conduct that would place the protected person(s) in reasonable fear of bodily injury to that person; and You are prohibited from the use, attempted use, or threatened use of physical force against the protected person(s) that would reasonable be expect to cause bodily injury.

On December 4, 2025, at 5:54 p.m., officers from the Mankato Department of Public Safety were dispatched to a report that two people, including Fox, were in the entryway of a building with a dog. The building is Protected Party's residence. Officers arrested Fox for the DANCO Violation.

Investigation revealed that Fox had been hanging out in the hallway of the building for about three days. At about 5:00 p.m., Fox approached Protected Person's residence door and knocked on it. Protected Person answered the door. Fox asked to go into the apartment. Protected Person told her to leave.

Fox has two prior convictions for violating a DANCO: a misdemeanor in 07-CR-22-3719 on December 12, 2023, and a gross misdemeanor in 07-CR-25-293 on August 11, 2025.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
