The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I**

**Charge: Harassment; Restraining Order-Violate w/in 10 yrs of prev domestic violence conviction/adjudication**

Minnesota Statute: 609.748.6(c)

Maximum Sentence: 364 days or \$3,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 06/08/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26012156

Charge Description: On or about June 8, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Nathan Gregory Beltz did violate a restraining order issued under M.S. 609.748 within ten years of a previous qualified domestic violence-related offense conviction or adjudication of delinquency.

## STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On June 8, 2026, Deputy Hagen of the Blue Earth County Sheriff's Office responded to Residence 1 in the City of Mankato in response to a harassment restraining order violation.

On November 8, 2024, the Honorable Gregory Anderson issued a Harassment Restraining Order prohibiting Nathan Gregory Beltz (DOB: 10/20/1977) from being within 100 feet of Residence 1. The Order was personally served upon Beltz on June 28, 2025 by the Blue Earth County Sheriff's Office. The Order is effective until November 8, 2026.

Deputy Hagen spoke with Victim 1. He reported that Beltz had entered the driveway at Residence 1.

Deputy Hagen also spoke with Victim 2, the original petitioner. She reported that she arrived home on June 8, 2026, and Beltz came up the driveway to Residence 1 yelling at her.

Beltz has a prior conviction for Violation of a Harassment Restraining Order. See Court File # 07-CR-23-2513.

## SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:  
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
