COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Assault - 4th Degree - Peace Officer - Demonstrable bodily harm

Minnesota Statute: 609.2231.1(c)(1)

Maximum Sentence: 3 years or \$6,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 08/01/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26024149

Charge Description: On or about August 1, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Juan Felipe Esquivel Reyna did physically assault and inflict demonstrable bodily harm upon a peace officer licensed under state law who was effecting a lawful arrest or executing any other duty imposed by law.

COUNT II

Charge: Obstruct Legal Process-Interfere w/Peace Officer

Minnesota Statute: 609.50.1(2), with reference to: 609.50.2(2)

Maximum Sentence: 364 days or \$3,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 08/01/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26024149

Charge Description: On or about August 1, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Juan Felipe Esquivel Reyna did, intentionally, obstruct, resist, or interfere with a peace officer while the officer was engaged in the performance of official duties and the act was accompanied by force or violence or the threat thereof.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On August 1, 2026, at approximately 2:25 AM, officers of the Mankato Department of Public Safety were dispatched to a welfare check regarding a male who was sitting on the steps to a business near the downtown area.

Officers arrived and made contact with the male, who was later identified as Juan Felipe Esquivel Reyna (dob 6/6/2002). Reyna was obviously intoxicated. Officers determined that Reyna was unable to care for himself. He submitted a portable breath test which resulted in a .243 reading.

Officers attempted to contact family members of Reyna to care for him but they were not comfortable caring for Reyna as he can be violent and uncontrollable when intoxicated.

Officers made arrangements to place Reyna in a detoxification facility. Reyna was transported to the Public Safety Center to await further transportation. Reyna was initially cooperative. Reyna then became increasingly upset. Reyna began slapping the walls, banging his head on the wall, and shouting. Officers attempted to use a WRAP restraining system in order to stop Reyna from engaging in self-injurious and assaultive behavior.

While attempting to restrain Reyna, Reyna approached the cell door and forcefully slammed his forehead into the window. Reyna fell to the ground and groaned in pain. Officers summoned an ambulance to check on Reyna. Reyna became increasingly upset and began shouting racial slurs and profanities at officers and medics. At one point, Reyna extended his neck and bit an officer's hand which caused an injury and bleeding.

Reyna was eventually transported to the hospital.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
