The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Drugs - 5th Degree - Possess Schedule 1,2,3,4 or paraphernalia residual - Not cannabis/hemp

Minnesota Statute: 152.025.2(a)(1), with reference to: 152.025.4(b)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years or \$10,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 02/20/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26005262

Charge Description: On or about February 20, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, John Martin West, did unlawfully possess one or more mixtures containing a controlled substance classified in schedule I, II, III, or IV, except cannabis flower, cannabis products, lower-potency hemp edibles, or hemp-derived consumer products or a residual amount of one or more mixtures of controlled substances contained in drug paraphernalia, and the mixture does not include any amount of a controlled substance in a fluid used in a water pipe and said controlled substance was more than .25 grams or 1 dosage unit.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

In the afternoon on February 20, 2026, Officers from the Mankato Department of Public Safety were notified that John Martin West (DOB: 04/29/1975) was at Business 1 in the City of Mankato, Blue Earth County. It was known that West had outstanding warrants for his arrest. Officers went to Business 1 and placed West under arrest. West was searched incident to arrest, and Officers discovered in West's possession a small plastic baggie with a crystalline substance inside it, weighing .47 grams, and a glass, bulbous pipe with white and burnt residue. Both items NIK-tested positive for methamphetamine.

West is currently in custody at the Blue Earth County Jail. The State requests a Warrant for that reason and because West has no known permanent or mailing address.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
