The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Domestic Assault-GM-Subsequent Violation

Minnesota Statute: 609.2242.2

Maximum Sentence: 364 days or \$3,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 07/04/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26020768

Charge Description: On or about July 4, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Kaylee Joy Sumner, did, against a family or household member, as defined in M.S.A. 518B.01 Subd. 2, intentionally inflict or attempt to inflict bodily harm upon another and has a previous qualified domestic violence-related offense conviction or an adjudication of delinquency within ten years.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Early in the morning on July 4, 2026, Officers from the Mankato Department of Public Safety were dispatched to a residence in Blue Earth County following report of a domestic disturbance. The complainant, Victim 1, reported Victim 1's daughter, Kaylee Joy Sumner (DOB: 08/18/2002) shoved and punched Victim 1. Victim 1 said Sumner was drunk and trying to leave Victim 1's residence with Sumner's daughter.

Officer Gelle went to the residence and spoke with Victim 1 who said Sumner had been drinking all day and then left the residence later in the day and got lost. When Sumner returned to the residence and tried to leave with Sumner's 8-year-old daughter, Victim 1 would not let Sumner leave because Sumner was too intoxicated. Sumner then pushed Victim 1 into a door and swung at Victim 1 but could not connect with Victim 1 because Victim 1 was holding back Sumner.

Victim 1 advised Victim 1 was worried Sumner was going to continue to assault Victim 1 as Sumner has previously done.

Officer McCarville made contact with Sumner at the residence. Sumner admitted to consuming three mixed drinks. Sumner provided a PBT sample which returned a result of .154 BAC.

Sumner said Victim 1 would not let Sumner have Sumner's daughter, which made Sumner kind of mad. Sumner denied hitting Victim 1 or breaking anything in Victim 1's residence.

Sumner was adjudicated delinquent of Assault in the Second Degree on May 11, 2020, in Court File No. 07-JV-20-86.

Because Sumner is at a detoxification facility, the State requests a Warrant.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
