The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Giving Peace Officer False Name-of Another Person

Minnesota Statute: 609.506.2

Maximum Sentence: 364 days or \$3,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 04/26/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26012838

Charge Description: On or about April 26, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Eugene Deshawn Brown did, with intent to obstruct justice, give the name and date of birth of another person to a peace officer when that officer makes inquiries incident to a lawful investigatory stop or lawful arrest, or inquiries incident to executing any other duty imposed by law.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

In the morning on April 26, 2026, Officer McCarville from the Mankato Department of Public Safety was dispatched to Business 1 in the City of Mankato, Blue Earth County, following a report that a man there was panhandling, and management at Business 1 wanted the man to stop.

When Officer McCarville arrived to Business 1, he observed a man matching the description given. McCarville observed the man notice McCarville and then walk away to the other side of the building. McCarville followed the man and made contact with him while the man was seated in the passenger seat of a vehicle with license plate RRZ806. The man said he was trying to get a bus ticket home to the cities. The man said he did not have a license but identified himself as Paul Brown (DOB: 10/21/1992). McCarville instructed the man not to panhandle on the property.

As McCarville walked back to his squad car, he noted the vehicle in which the man was sitting was already gone. McCarville ran Paul Brown's information through the state system and learned Paul Brown has an address in Duluth and did not have the same description of the man at Business 1.

McCarville looked for contacts by police with a vehicle bearing the license plate RRZ806 and discovered the name Eugene Deshawn Brown (DOB: 05/21/1988) with an address in Brooklyn Center, MN. Eugene Brown's description matched the man's at Business 1. Eugene Brown had felony warrants out of Hennepin and Becker County.

McCarville circled the parking lot at Business 1 and saw the vehicle with license plate RRZ806. McCarville activated his emergency lights and made contact with the occupants, confirming Eugene Brown was the man McCarville spoke with about panhandling.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
