COMPLAINT

Summons

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Theft-Take/Use/Transfer Movable Prop-No Consent

Minnesota Statute: 609.52.2(a)(1), with reference to: 609.52.3(2)

Maximum Sentence: 10 years or \$20,000, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 03/01/2025 to 03/31/2025

Control #(ICR#): 25007173

Charge Description: On or between March 1, 2025 and March 31, 2025, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Logan Lee Anderson, did, intentionally and without claim of right take, use, transfer, conceal or retain possession of the movable property of another without the other's consent and with intent to deprive the owner permanently of possession of the property and the value of the property or services stolen exceeded \$5,000.00.

COUNT II

Charge: Theft-Find and Appropriate Lost Property

Minnesota Statute: 609.52.2(a)(6), with reference to: 609.52.3(2)

Maximum Sentence: 10 years or \$20,000, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 03/01/2025 to 03/31/2025

Control #(ICR#): 25007173

Charge Description: On or between March 1, 2025 and March 31, 2025, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Logan Lee Anderson, did, find lost property and, knowing or having reasonable means of ascertaining the true owner, appropriates it to the finder's own use or to that of another not entitled thereto without first having made reasonable effort to find the owner and offer and surrender the property to the owner.

COUNT III

Charge: Receiving Stolen Property

Minnesota Statute: 609.53.1, with reference to: 609.52.3(2)

Maximum Sentence: 10 years or \$20,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 03/01/2025 to 03/31/2025

Control #(ICR#): 25007173

Charge Description: On or between March 1, 2025 and March 31, 2025, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Logan Lee Anderson did receive, possess, transfer, buy or conceal any stolen property or property obtained by robbery, knowing or having reason to know the property was stolen or obtained by robbery and the value of the property is over \$5,000.00.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

In March 2025, the Mankato Department of Public Safety became aware of a fraud report by Victim 1. Victim 1 stated that he banks with Bank 1 located in Mankato, Minnesota, Blue Earth County. On March 1, 2025, \$9,500 was fraudulently transferred out of his savings account through a single electronic transfer at the time, Victim 1 had no idea who did this.

In December of 2025, LETSS Mathiowetz obtained more information about the transfer. LETSS Mathiowetz learned that the transfer went into the account of Logan Lee Anderson (dob 3/3/2005). Victim 1 said he did not know who Anderson was.

LETSS Mathiowetz obtained bank information regarding Anderson's account. LETSS Mathiowetz observed the following:

03/01/2025 balance for Logan's account- \$5.16
03/01/2025 at 0905- \$9505.16
03/01/2025- \$5000.00 cash withdrawal- 11:08
03/01/2025- \$1026.00- Mystic Lake Casino 12:24
03/01/2025-\$1026.00- Little Six Casino 12:41
03/03/25- Cash App- Logan Anderson \$500.00 x 2
03/03/25- Cash App- Logan Anderson \$400.00
03/31/25- Closing date balance \$30.88

LETSS Mathiowetz observed the photo from bank of cash withdrawal on March 1, 2025, and noted it looks similar to Anderson's driver's license photo.

LETSS Mathiowetz spoke with Anderson. When asked about the activity, Anderson stated he may have gone to a casino around that time. Anderson claimed not to know anything about the large transfer into his account. Anderson admitted seeing a higher-than-normal balance and withdrew cash.

LETSS Mathiowetz obtained records from Mystic Lake/Little Six Casinos. The records showed Anderson getting a credit card advance for \$2,000 total.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
