COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Obstruct Legal Process-Interfere w/Peace Officer

Minnesota Statute: 609.50.1(2)

Maximum Sentence: 364 days or \$3,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 08/23/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26026839

Charge Description: On or about August 23, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Kyla Ann Olson did, intentionally, obstruct, resist, or interfere with a peace officer while the officer was engaged in the performance of official duties and the act was accompanied by force or violence or the threat thereof.

COUNT II

Charge: Liquor-Consumption by persons under 21

Minnesota Statute: 340A.503.1(a)(2)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days or \$1,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 08/23/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26026839

Charge Description: On or about August 23, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Kyla Ann Olson did, while under the age of 21 years, consume an alcoholic beverage.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On August 23, 2026, Officers of the Mankato Department of Public Safety were on directed foot patrol in the City of Mankato. Officers walked in the direction of a group of individuals who were consuming alcohol. Three youthful-appearing individuals—two females and a male—abruptly began walking away from the gathering upon seeing law enforcement. Officers observed the male openly consuming alcohol and one of the females had a backpack.

Officers made contact with the female with the backpack, identified as Kyla Olson (DOB: 11/14/2006). Olson dropped the backpack on the ground and officers heard the sounds of cans hitting together. Olson stated she was 19 years old. Olson's eyes were glassy and officers observed the odor of alcoholic beverage. Olson admitted she had consumed "quite a bit" of alcohol. Olson's backpack contained a number of unopened alcoholic beverages.

Olson began arguing with officers and attempted to grab the backpack from law enforcement. Officer Wagner took hold of Olson's arm to prevent her from taking the backpack. Olson then tried to pull her arm away from Officer Wagner and took a step backwards. Officers placed her into handcuffs. Officer Coutier escorted Olson to a squad car. Olson contorted her body, pulled away from Officer Coutier, tried to spin and step away from Officer Coutier, and planted her feet. Officers detained Olson in a squad car.

Officers returned to the squad car to assess Olson's level of cooperation. They removed her from the squad car and she immediately began arguing. When officers moved to place her back in the squad car, Olson tensed her muscles, lowered her center of gravity, and pushed against the squad car.

Olson provided a PBT with a result of .104.

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
