The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNTI

Charge: Giving Peace Officer False Name-of Another Person

Minnesota Statute: 609.506.2

Maximum Sentence: 364 days or \$3,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 08/30/2025

Control #(ICR#): 25024827

Charge Description: On or about August 30, 2025 at 5:00 PM, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Timothy John Johannsen did, with intent to obstruct justice, give the name and date of birth of another person to a peace officer when that officer makes inquiries incident to a lawful investigatory stop or lawful arrest, or inquiries incident to executing any other duty imposed by law.

COUNT II

Charge: Theft-Take/Use/Transfer Movable Prop-No Consent

Minnesota Statute: 609.52.2(a)(1), with reference to: 609.52.3(5)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days or \$1,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 08/30/2025

Control #(ICR#): 25024827

Charge Description: On or about August 30, 2025 at 5:00 PM, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Timothy John Johannsen did, intentionally and without claim of right, take, use, transfer, conceal or retain possession of the movable property of another without the other's consent and with intent to deprive the owner permanently of possession of the property.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On August 30, 2025, officers from the Mankato Department of Public Safety were dispatched to a theft at a Mankato business. The suspect's vehicle was described as a blue Chevrolet pickup truck. The pickup also had "whiskey plates." As Officer Hullopeter headed to the business in a squad car and saw the truck heading toward him. The truck was a blue 2007 Chevrolet Silverado with Minnesota license plates numbered WT 1283. The officer stopped the truck

Officer Hullopeter spoke to the driver and noted that the passenger in the truck matched the description of the theft suspect. The passenger, unknown to officers, identified himself using the name and date of birth of a close male relative.

A short time later, Office McGuire discovered that the theft suspect / truck passenger was, in fact, Timothy John Johannsen (DOB 04/07/1977). Officer Hullopeter examined the DMV photo of Timothy John Johannsen and found it matched the passenger. Investigation further revealed that Timothy John Johannsen had the same relative's name listed as an alias on state registration paperwork.

Mankato Business 1 identified Timothy John Johannsen as the shoplifter who went to an automated checkout counter, but loaded other items into the bag without scanning them. When confronted by store security, he left the store without paying. The stolen items totaled \$65.90.
