**COMPLAINT**

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I**

**Charge: Financial Transaction Card Fraud-Sell/Transf Card**

Minnesota Statute: 609.821.2(3), with reference to: 609.821.3(a)(2)

Maximum Sentence: 3 years or \$5,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 03/28/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26009267

Charge Description: On or about March 28, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Rebekah Rekae Aegerter did sell or transfer a card knowing that the cardholder and issuer have not authorized the person to whom the card is sold or transferred to use the card.

**COUNT II**

**Charge: Theft-Take/Use/Transfer Movable Prop-No Consent**

Minnesota Statute: 609.52.2(a)(1), with reference to: 609.52.3(5)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days or \$1,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 03/28/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26009267

Charge Description: On or about March 28, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Rebekah Rekae Aegerter did, intentionally and without claim of right, take, use, transfer, conceal or retain possession of the movable property of another without the other's consent and with intent to deprive the owner permanently of possession of the property.

## STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On March 28, 2026, Officer Honetschlager of the Mankato Department of Public Safety was dispatched to a report of a theft at Business 1. Officer Honetschlager spoke to Victim, who reported she and Witness 1 were at Business 1 on March 28th until around 11:00 PM. After leaving, Victim 1 realized she left her purse hanging on her chair at Business 1. She returned shortly after leaving and the purse was gone. During the morning of March 29, Victim noted unauthorized activity on her debit card that was inside her purse.

After speaking with Victim, while responding to a separate incident, Officer Honetschlager detained Rebekah Rekae Aegerter (DOB 11/18/2003) after Aegerter fled officers. Located in Aegerter's purse was multiple items belonging to Victim, including Victim's DL and multiple financial transaction cards.

Aegerter told Officer Honetschlager that she and her friends saw Victim's purse being left behind and her friend told her to take it, which Aegerter did. Aegerter then went to some bars and when she left downtown she dumped the purse and took the contents. While at a residence, Aegerter then took Victim's bank card and gave it Witness 2, and Witness 2 used the card to purchase fast food.

## SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:  
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or  
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
