**COMPLAINT**

Order of Detention

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The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I**

**Charge: Domestic Assault - By Strangulation**

Minnesota Statute: 609.2247.2

Maximum Sentence: 3 years or \$5,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 06/28/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26020106

Charge Description: On or about June 28, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Alonzo Reganld Wilson did assault a family or household member by strangulation.

**COUNT II**

**Charge: Domestic Assault-Misdemeanor-Intentionally Inflicts/Attempts to Inflict Bodily Harm on Another**

Minnesota Statute: 609.2242.1(2)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days or \$1,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 06/28/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26020106

Charge Description: On or about June 28, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Alonzo Reganld Wilson, did, against a family or household member, as defined in M.S.A. 518B.01 Subd. 2, intentionally inflict or attempt to inflict bodily harm upon another.

## STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On June 27th, 2026, officers from the Mankato Department of Public Safety responded to an apartment complex within the City of Mankato regarding a report of a domestic assault incident. Witness 1 called 911 stating that her friend, Victim 1, had contacted Witness 1 to state that her boyfriend (identified as Alonzo Reginald Wilson DOB: 11/18/1970) had assaulted her.

Witness 1 spoke with Sergeant Wood. Witness 1 stated that she had been contacted by Victim 1, with Victim 1 stating that Victim 1 had been beaten up by her boyfriend. Witness 1 informed Sergeant Wood that Victim 1 was no longer answering Witness 1's phone calls. Witness 1 also stated that she believed Victim 1 to be at Wilson's residence.

Sergeant Wood and other Mankato Police Officers, including Officer Strong, attempted to make contact with Victim 1 and Wilson at the apartment complex. After some time, Officer Koss made verbal contact with Wilson, who was inside the apartment and confirmed that Victim 1 was also inside. Wilson eventually came to the door and was placed under arrest.

Upon first contact with Victim 1, Sergeant Wood noted that Victim 1's right eye was swollen and a dark shade of a black bruise; Sergeant Wood also noted several fresh bruises and marked reddening on Victim 1's neck, collarbone, and upper chest/breast area.

Sergeant Wood and Officer Koss spoke with Victim 1 about the incident. Victim 1 stated that she is in a romantic relationship with Wilson and that she stays at his apartment. Victim 1 stated that Wilson attacked her unprovoked and first struck her in the chest area. Sergeant Wood noted that Victim 1 had bruising and marks on her chest region that are consistent with her statement. Victim 1 stated that Wilson then began choking her, which caused her to have her breathing interrupted. Victim 1 told Officer Koss that she was unable to recall how long Wilson had been choking her but that it felt like a long time and that he was never going to give up. Sergeant Wood and Officer Koss noted that Victim 1 had red marks and bruises around her neck that are consistent with a strangulation event.

Victim 1 also informed Sergeant Wood and Officer Koss that Wilson then struck her in the face and slammed her face first down onto the bed. Victim 1 reported that Wilson struck her near her eye and on her head several times. Sergeant Wood observed a black eye on Victim 1's right eye and Sergeant Wood noted that she could feel several swollen "goose-eggs" on Victim 1's head. Victim 1 also reported that she felt unsteady and foggy and felt as if she may have a concussion. Medics also informed Victim 1 and Sergeant Wood that Victim 1 had several cuts in her mouth related to the assaults. Victim 1 also told Sergeant Wood that she was extremely fearful of Wilson.

Officer Strong spoke with Wilson who stated that Wilson has been dating Victim 1 for approximately 8 months. Wilson stated they lived together at the apartment complex. Wilson informed Officer Strong that Wilson and Victim 1 got in an argument that got out of hand.

## SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:  
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or  
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
