The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Carry BB Gun/Rifle/Shotgun/Aslt Wpn-Public Place

Minnesota Statute: 624.7181.2

Maximum Sentence: 364 days or \$3,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 03/26/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26009096

Charge Description: On or about March 26, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Jaxon Richard Sageng did carry a BB gun in a public place.

COUNT II

Charge: Cannabis - 3rd Degree - Possess more than 16 g but not more than 80 g of cannabis concentrate

Minnesota Statute: 152.0263.3(2)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days or \$1,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 03/26/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26009096

Charge Description: On or about March 26, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Jaxon Richard Sageng, did unlawfully possess more than 16 grams but not more than 80 grams of cannabis concentrate.

COUNT III

Charge: Cannabis open package - Owner/Driver of motor vehicle; Not compliant packaging or container

Minnesota Statute: 169A.36.4(1)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days or \$1,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 03/26/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26009096

Charge Description: On or about March 26, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Jaxon Richard Sageng, did have in possession, while in a private motor vehicle on a street or highway, any cannabis flower, cannabis product, a lower-potency hemp edible, a hemp-derived consumer product, or any other product containing an artificially derived cannabinoid that was not in packaging or another container compliant with Chapter 152 or Chapter 342.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

In the evening on March 26, 2026, Officer Colton Pike was patrolling an area in the City of Mankato, Blue Earth County, when he observed a vehicle with a dark-tinted rear window that appeared to be in violation of Minnesota Statutes section 169.71. After conducting a traffic stop, Officer Pike noted the rear window was so dark it was difficult to see into the rear seat. The driver of the vehicle was identified as Jaxon Richard Sageng (DOB: 12/07/2007). Officer Pike smelled a strong odor of marijuana coming from the open driver's-side window. Sageng stated there was marijuana in the vehicle, retrieved it from the open compartment near the gear shifter, and showed Officer Pike the marijuana was packaged in a clear sandwich baggie.

Sageng complied with Pike's instruction to exit Sageng's vehicle and consented to a search of Sageng's person which revealed several electronic vaporizers, suspected of containing THC. Sageng said there were more "carts" in the center console which Pike understood to mean THC electronic vaporizer cartridges. Sageng also admitted there was a BB gun in Sageng's backpack on the floor in front of the front passenger seat, near where a passenger had been sitting. Sageng said the BB gun made Sageng feel "safer."

Police searched the vehicle and located 14.90 grams of a green, leafy substance that field tested positive for marijuana, a digital scale, eight sealed THC vaporizers, containing two grams of concentrate each, a second digital scale and marijuana pipe, two other THC vaporizers, and a Glock 17 BB handgun with a serial number that appeared partly obliterated. Sageng does not have a permit to carry.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
