**COMPLAINT**

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I**

**Charge: Assault - 4th Degree - Peace Officer - Physically Assaults**

Minnesota Statute: 609.2231.1(b)

Maximum Sentence: 364 days or \$3,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 07/05/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26020857

Charge Description: On or about July 5, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Nya Bath David Wiegong did physically assault a peace officer when that officer was effecting a lawful arrest or executing any other duty imposed by law.

**COUNT II**

**Charge: Obstruct Legal Process-Interfere w/Peace Officer**

Minnesota Statute: 609.50.1(2)

Maximum Sentence: 364 days or \$3,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 07/05/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26020857

Charge Description: On or about July 5, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Nya Bath David Wiegong did, intentionally, obstruct, resist, or interfere with a peace officer while the officer was engaged in the performance of official duties and the act was accompanied by force or violence or the threat thereof.

**COUNT III**

**Charge: Damage to Property - 3rd Degree - Public safety motor vehicle**

Minnesota Statute: 609.595.2(a)(2)

Maximum Sentence: 364 days or \$3,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 07/05/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26020857

Charge Description: On or about July 5, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Nya Bath David Wiegong did and intentionally, and without the consent of the owner or person in lawful possession, cause damage to physical property and the damage was to a public safety motor vehicle and the defendant knew the vehicle was a public safety vehicle.

## STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Shortly after midnight on July 5, 2026, Officers from the Mankato Department of Public Safety were dispatched to a residence in Blue Earth County following report of a domestic assault. Witness 1 reported that Witness 1's sister, Nya Bath David Wiegong (DOB: 11/03/1995) smacked Witness 1 in the face. Witness 1 said Wiegong was intoxicated. Witness 2, Wiegong's family member, said Wiegong has been intoxicated all week and unable to care for Wiegong's child. Witness 1 later denied Wiegong hit Witness 1 and said Wiegong spit in Witness 1's face.

When Officer Christianson responded to the call, he observed Wiegong walking in the middle of the street near the residence. Christianson made contact with Wiegong and told her she was not free to leave. Officers decided to detain Wiegong because she was behaving erratically and refusing to follow Officers' instructions.

After Christianson placed handcuffs on Wiegong's wrists, Wiegong became highly agitated and cursed at Officers while turning and pulling away from them. When Christianson placed his left hand on Wiegong's right shoulder, Wiegong jumped forward aggressively and began to thrash around. Her thrashing caused Wiegong and Christianson to lose their footing and they both collided with the rear passenger door of Christianson's patrol car.

While Wiegong continued to yell at Christianson, he felt Wiegong's saliva landing on his face and arms. After Christianson told Wiegong to stop multiple times, Wiegong kicked Christianson in the feet and legs and pulled away from Christianson. Officer Hickey observed Wiegong's assaultive conduct.

When Officers walked Wiegong to the backseat of Christianson's squad car, Wiegong threw her body into Christianson, saying, "stop moving me like that, bitch!" After Officers instructed Wiegong to sit in the vehicle, Wiegong threw her right shoulder into Christianson's chest. Once she sat in the vehicle, she kicked Christianson in his upper leg three or four times, causing him pain and soreness.

After transporting Wiegong to the Blue Earth County Jail, Christianson discovered the rear passenger door of his squad car had been damaged when he and Wiegong crashed into it, due to Wiegong's forceful obstruction. Specifically, Christianson observed three dents and scratches.

## SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:  
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or  
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
