The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Drugs - 3rd Degree - Possess 10 grams or more a narcotic drug other than heroin or fentanyl

Minnesota Statute: 152.023.2(a)(1), with reference to: 152.023.3(a)

Maximum Sentence: 20 years or \$250,000, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 02/12/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26004424

Charge Description: On or about February 12, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Kristie Lynn Harroun did on one or more occasions within a 90-day period unlawfully possess one or more mixtures of a total weight of ten grams or more containing a narcotic drug other than heroin or fentanyl.

COUNT II

Charge: Carry BB Gun/Rifle/Shotgun/Aslt Wpn-Public Place

Minnesota Statute: 624.7181.2

Maximum Sentence: 364 days or \$3,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 02/12/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26004424

Charge Description: On or about February 12, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Kristie Lynn Harroun did carry a BB gun in a public place.

COUNT III

Charge: Traffic - Open bottle law; Possession; crime described

Minnesota Statute: 169A.35.3, with reference to: 169A.35.5

Maximum Sentence: 90 Days or \$1,000.00 fine or both

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 02/12/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26004424

Charge Description: On or about February 12, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Kristie Lynn Harroun, did have in his/her possession, while in a private motor vehicle upon a street or highway, any bottle or receptacle containing an alcoholic beverage, distilled spirit or 3.2 percent malt liquor that has been opened, or the seal broken, or the contents of which have been partially removed.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On February 12, 2026, Officer Honetschlager of the Mankato Department of Public Safety was operating an un-marked squad car. Officer Honetschlager completed an unrelated traffic stop near Warren St. in Mankato when he observed a white Dodge Ram truck with crash damage to the left rear light and rear fender of the truck. Officer Honetschlager observed the vehicle failing to signal for two left-turns near Warren St. and 4th St.

Officer Honetschlager conducted a traffic stop of the vehicle and identified the driver as Kristie Lynn Harroun (DOB: 07/21/1978). Harroun was found to have an active warrant for her arrest. After Harroun was placed under arrest, Officer Honetschlager conducted a search of the immediate area where Harroun was seated. Officer Terry arrived on scene and assisted in the search.

Officers located Harroun's purse within the truck. The contents of the purse included identification for Harroun, as well as a Ziploc style baggie containing two large crystal-like objects. The contents of the baggie weighed 17.33 grams and field tested positive for methamphetamine.

Officer Honetschlager continued his search of the truck and located a BB gun in the center console of the truck. Officer Honetschlager also located an open and partially empty bottle of 1.75L Gray Duck Vodka on the floorboard of the truck.

Officers spoke with Harroun and Harroun admitted that the substance in the Ziploc baggie was methamphetamine and that it was hers. Harroun also told officers that she last used methamphetamine earlier that day. Harroun also acknowledged that the BB gun found in the truck was hers.

At the time of writing this Complaint, Harroun is on warrant status in numerous files including for Felony charges in 43-CR-25-2073, 07-CR-25-1819, and 47-CR-24-1058. At this time Harroun's whereabouts are unknown. Due to her warrant status and unknown whereabouts, a Complaint Warrant is requested.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.

Complainant declares under penalty of perjury that everything stated in this document is true and correct. Minn. Stat. § 358.116; Minn. R. Crim. P. 2.01, subds. 1, 2.
