The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Possession of Burglary or Theft Tools

Minnesota Statute: 609.59

Maximum Sentence: 3 years or \$5,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 12/03/2025

Control #(ICR#): 25034633

Charge Description: On or about December 3, 2025, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Jaosha Keona Shanpez Stevenson did have in his/her possession any device, explosive, or other instrumentality with intent to use or permit the use of the same to commit burglary or theft.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

In the afternoon on December 3, 2025, officers from the Mankato Department of Public Safety responded to a complaint from Business 1 in Blue Earth County regarding three individuals attempting to shoplift. Reportedly, one of the individuals left Business 1 and was observed walking towards Business 2. Police received clear images of the individuals involved and located one of the individuals, Jaosha Keona Shanpez Stevenson (DOB: 10/20/1991) in the bathroom at Business 2. After Officer Hickey read Stevenson the Miranda warning, Stevenson admitted trying to steal headphones from Business 1 and using an instrument to disable a security device attached to the headphones, to accomplish the theft. Staff from Business 1 reported Stevenson and two other individuals removed the same kind of security device from another product while inside Business 1. Officer Christianson viewed security footage from Business 1 and observed Stevenson using an object to remove the security device from that product.

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
