COMPLAINT

Warrant

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Attempted Disarming a Peace Officer - Take Defensive Device from Peace Officer/Area Controlled by Officer

Minnesota Statute: 609.504.2, with reference to: 609.17.1
Maximum Sentence: 5 years or \$10,000 fine, or both
Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 03/13/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26007464

Charge Description: On or about March 13, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Timothy Wayne Parsons did intentionally take possession of a defensive device being carried by a peace officer or from the area within the officer's immediate control, without the officer's consent while the officer is engaged in the performance of official duties.

COUNT II

Charge: Obstruct Legal Process-Interfere w/Peace Officer

Minnesota Statute: 609.50.1(2), with reference to: 609.50.2(2)
Maximum Sentence: 364 days or \$3,000 fine, or both
Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 03/13/2026

Charge Description: On or about March 13, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Timothy Wayne Parsons did, intentionally, obstruct, resist, or interfere with a peace officer while the officer was engaged in the performance of official duties and the act was accompanied by force or violence or the threat thereof.

COUNT III

Charge: Assault - 4th Deg - Physician, nurse or other emergency room personnel

Minnesota Statute: 609.2231.2(a)(2), with reference to: 609.2231.2(a)

Maximum Sentence: 364 days and or \$3,000 fine

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 03/13/2026

Charge Description: On or about March 13, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Timothy Wayne Parsons did assault a physician, nurse, or other person providing health care services in a hospital emergency department.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On March 13, 2026, Dispatch received multiple phone calls reporting a suicidal male Timothy Wayne Parsons (DOB 09-28-1984) at a sober living facility located in Mankato, Minnesota which is located within Blue Earth County. It was reported that A 42-year-old male was cutting his wrist with a knife, but he no longer had possession of the knife.

Officer Brianna Wagner of Mankato Department of Public Safety responded to the call for service and immediately spoke with Witness 1. Witness 1 warned Officer Wagner that Parsons said he was going to fight when Law Enforcement arrived. Parsons was sitting on the floor and holding a towel wrapped around his left wrist. Officer Wagner observed blood spots on the towel. Officer Wagner introduced herself to Parsons, and Parsons responded with, "What side do you carry your gun?" Witness 1 indicated that Parsons no longer had a knife in his possession. Parsons also said, "I'm already seeing what I want." While staring at Officer Wagner's duty belt.

Parsons moved himself into a crouched position and appeared he was trying to stand. Officer Wagner used her training to apply gentle pressure to keep him flat on the ground and informed Parson that she was not going to let him stand up. Parson's continued his behavior by stating, "I just want to die, I want an officer to put a bullet in my fucking head" and "put a bullet, what do I have to do for you to put one in the back of my fucking skull?" and I while Officer Wagner checked Parson's pockets he stated, " I have a fucking wallet, you're carrying a weapon, maybe if I disarmed you..." "I want to die." Parsons continued to repeatedly make statements concerning the Officers weapon, and how he wanted to die. Several other Officers arrived on scene to help control the situation. Parsons tried multiple times to reach for Officer's weapons, and it appeared that he was trying to force an Officer response with deadly force.

While trying to gain control of Parsons, he would make forceful movements, tense his muscles, yell and continued to pull away from Officers. Eventually Officers were able to utilize the WRAP system. Parsons was placed in an ambulance and brought to the hospital. While at the hospital Parsons continued to be resistive Officers and hospital staff. Parsons made threatening remarks to Officers and Emergency room Staff promising to fight them. In addition, Parsons spit on one of the emergency room nurses Victim 1.

When law enforcement Officers spoke with Witness 2 and Witness 3 it was learned that Parsons has a history of alcohol abuse and has previously been caught drinking alcohol at the sober living facility. Parsons may have been drinking prior to this incident and that Parsons was going through several personal matters. It was also indicated that Parsons had left the house for a couple hours prior to this incident. During the incident Officers observed Parsons display indicators of impairment such as, slurred speech, forced speech, and odor of alcohol emitting from his person.

Due to the situation at the sober living house and hospital Parsons has been placed on a hold and a Body Warrant is appropriate here.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
