COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Drugs - 3rd Degree - Sale - Narcotic

Minnesota Statute: 152.023.1(1), with reference to: 152.023.3(a)

Maximum Sentence: 20 years or \$250,000, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 09/18/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26030153

Charge Description: On or about September 18, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Anthony Marshaun Jackson, did, unlawfully sell one or more mixtures containing a narcotic drug.

COUNT II

Charge: Drugs - 3rd Degree - Possess 10 grams or more a narcotic drug other than heroin or fentanyl

Minnesota Statute: 152.023.2(a)(1), with reference to: 152.023.3(a)

Maximum Sentence: 20 years or \$250,000

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 09/18/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26030153

Charge Description: On or about September 18, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Anthony Marshaun Jackson did on one or more occasions within a 90-day period unlawfully possess one or more mixtures of a total weight of ten grams or more containing a narcotic drug other than heroin or fentanyl.

COUNT III

Charge: Drugs - 3rd Degree - Possess - Methamphet/Amphetamine in School/Park/Pub Housing Zone

Minnesota Statute: 152.023.2(a)(6), with reference to: 152.023.3(a)

Maximum Sentence: 20 years or \$250,000, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 09/18/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26030153

Charge Description: On or about September 18, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Anthony Marshaun Jackson did unlawfully possesses one or more mixtures containing methamphetamine or amphetamine in a school zone, a park zone, a public housing zone, or a drug treatment facility.

COUNT IV

Charge: Cannabis open package - Possess in motor vehicle; Not compliant packaging or container

Minnesota Statute: 169A.36.3(1), with reference to: 169A.36.5

Maximum Sentence: 90 days or \$1,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 09/18/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26030153

Charge Description: On or about September 18, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Anthony Marshaun Jackson, had in possession while in a private motor vehicle on a street or highway, any cannabis flower, a cannabis product, a lower-potency hemp edible, a hemp-derived consumer product, or any other product containing an artificially derived cannabinoid that is in packaging or another container that does not comply with the relevant packaging requirements in chapter 152 or 342.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Late in the evening on September 18, 2026, Officer Keane from the Mankato Department of Public Safety was on patrol in the City of Mankato, Blue Earth County, when he observed an unknown male in the driver's seat of a vehicle at Business 1, with two unknown people outside the vehicle, speaking with the driver. It appeared to Officer Keane the individuals had met there.

When the vehicle left the parking lot, Keane observed an object hanging from the rearview mirror, a violation of Minnesota traffic code. Keane followed the vehicle and when the vehicle made a left turn, the left-turn signal was activated simultaneously, not 100 feet prior to the turn as required by law. Keane conducted a traffic stop and made contact with the driver, Anthony Marshaun Jackson (DOB: 11/17/1981). The path of Jackson's travel included a school zone, park zone, or public housing zone.

Keane observed Jackson's eyes were bloodshot and watery and there was a strong odor of marijuana coming from inside Jackson's vehicle. Jackson said he smoked marijuana earlier in the day. It appeared to Keane that Jackson was nervous, as Jackson avoided eye contact and mumbled, lacking confidence in his speech.

Keane learned the status of Jackson's driver's license was revoked and that Jackson had had several drug charges in the last five years. Keane asked Jackson how much marijuana was in the car, and Jackson retrieved a glass pipe from the center console with a green, leafy substance inside it that smelled like marijuana and was not properly packaged.

Keane told Jackson that Jackson was being detained and Keane was going to search his vehicle for more marijuana. Keane searched Jackson's person and found a digital scale in Jackson's right pant leg cargo pocket. Jackson said he weighs marijuana for blunts.

In a cup holder in Jackson's vehicle, Keane found a small, clear baggie containing a green, leafy substance. In a plastic bag on the front right passenger seat, Keane found a glass bubble pipe with burnt white residue inside it. Keane asked Jackson if Jackson had methamphetamine on Jackson or in the vehicle. Jackson said there was methamphetamine in a purple backpack in the backseat. Jackson said it was in a small pocket on the side.

In the purple backpack, Keane found a curved glass pipe with burnt white residue that NIK-tested positive for methamphetamine. Also in the backpack was a small clear plastic baggie with a large crystalline rock-like object that NIK-tested positive for methamphetamine and weighed 9.25 grams. In the same backpack pocket were several small plastic baggies. Keane placed Jackson under arrest and transported him to the Blue Earth County Jail.

Jail staff located on Jackson's person a small plastic baggie with a crystalline substance that NIK-tested positive for methamphetamine and weighed 1.02 grams.

Jackson was convicted on June 29, 2026, of violating Chapter 152, in Court File No. 07-CR-25-3946.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
