COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Threats of Violence-Reckless Disregard Risk

Minnesota Statute: 609.713.1

Maximum Sentence: 5 years or \$10,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 04/16/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26011687

Charge Description: On or about April 16, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Albert Brown Lurks Jr, did, threaten, directly or indirectly, to commit any crime of violence with purpose to terrorize another, or in a reckless disregard of the risk of causing such terror.

COUNT II

Charge: Theft-Take/Use/Transfer Movable Prop-No Consent

Minnesota Statute: 609.52.2(a)(1), with reference to: 609.52.3(5)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days or \$1,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 04/16/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26011687

Charge Description: On or about April 16, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Albert Brown Lurks Jr did, intentionally and without claim of right, take, use, transfer, conceal or retain possession of the movable property of another without the other's consent and with intent to deprive the owner permanently of possession of the property.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On April 16, 2016, at approximately 8:45 PM, Officer Noah Christ with Mankato Department of Public Safety was dispatched on a report of a threat that had occurred at a hotel in downtown of Mankato. Dispatch informed Ofc. Christ that the complainant, Victim 1, was an employee of the hotel and had reported that a person had threatened her a couple of hours ago.

Ofc. Christ contacted approximately Victim 1. Victim 1 stated that on April 16, 2026 at approximately 7:05 PM she was working at the hotel when a male walked into the lobby. The male would later be identified as Albert Brown Lurks, Jr.

Victim 1 stated that Lurks went into the pantry area of the lobby and grabbed a breakfast bag. The breakfast bags were for guests of the hotel only. Victim 1 told Lurks that he could not have the breakfast bag. Lurks asked Victim 1 if she could make an exception and Victim 1 told Lurks again that he could not have the breakfast bag.

Lurks then walked out of the hotel lobby with the breakfast bag. Victim 1 asked for the breakfast bag back. Lurks responded by stating she better let him have the breakfast bag because he had a knife in his backpack and was not afraid to take it out. Victim 1 then let Lurks keep the breakfast bag as he exited the hotel.

Victim 1 stated that because of the threat she felt stressed out, afraid and scared because Lurks had threatened to take his knife out. Victim 1 stated she was afraid that Lurks was going to take out the knife and stab her.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
