The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I**

**Charge: Felon Convicted Crime of Violence - Firearm Violation**

Minnesota Statute: 609.165.1b(a), with reference to: 609.11.5(b)

Maximum Sentence: 15 Years or \$30,000 fine or both.

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 02/14/2026 to 02/15/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26004823

Charge Description: On or between February 14, 2026 and February 15, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Kilasiku Shaheed Graham Jr did ship, transport, possess, or receive a firearm after having been convicted of a crime of violence.

## STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On February 15, 2026, Officer Koss of the Mankato Department of Public Safety was dispatched to a residence in Mankato, Minnesota, Blue Earth County. Witness 1 called and stated that her kid's father, Kilasiku Shaheed Graham Jr., and her got into a fight and he left. While doing so, he left a duffel bag outside her door and told her to bring it inside. Witness 1 stated she brought the bag inside and observed a firearm in it.

Officer Koss learned that Graham was prohibited from possessing a firearm under Minnesota law.

Officer Koss arrived and spoke with Witness 1. Officer Koss took Witness 1's statement about Graham leaving the duffel bag and her finding a firearm inside. Officer Koss took possession of the firearm. The firearm was a Tan Glock 19X handgun with two loaded magazines.

Graham was located on February 18th and arrested.

Graham is prohibited for life from possessing a firearm or ammunition based on a 5th Degree Controlled Substance Possession conviction on a April 14, 2022, in 08-CR-21-911.

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:  
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
