The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Aid and Abet Theft-Take/Use/Transfer Movable Prop-No Consent

Minnesota Statute: 609.52.2(a)(1), with reference to: 609.05.1, 609.52.3(3)(a)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years or \$10,000, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 06/07/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26017803

Charge Description: On or about June 7, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Arielle Rene Frederick, did, intentionally aid, advise, hire, counsel, or conspire with or otherwise procure the other to, without claim of right take, use, transfer, conceal or retain possession of the movable property of another without the other's consent and with intent to deprive the owner permanently of possession of the property and the value of the property or services stolen exceeded \$1,000.00.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On June 8, 2026, Officer Sokolov of the Mankato Department of Public Safety reported to Business 1 in the City of Mankato in response to a past-occurred shoplifting report.

Officer Sokolov spoke with Witness 1. She reported that the suspects from a shoplifting that occurred on June 7, 2026, Andrew James Underdahl (DOB: 8/31/1991) and Arielle Rene Frederick (DOB: 5/30/1996), had returned to the store.

On June 7, 2026, Underdahl and Frederick entered the store. Underdahl selected plastic folders. Underdahl then selected two Dyson vacuum cleaners and used a tool to defeat the merchandise protection. Underdahl then selected a Phillips coffee maker. Underdahl and Frederick went to the self-checkout. Together, they scanned the price tags for the plastic folders at the self-checkout, and left the store. Frederick assists Underdahl in placing a debit card in the machine.

They paid a total of \$7.08. The total value of the unpaid merchandise was \$2,729.97.

On June 8, 2026, Business 1 reported that Underdahl and Frederick returned to the store, then left in a Dodge SUV bearing MN plate TDM874. Law enforcement responded, located Underdahl and Frederick at Business 2, and arrested them both.

Law enforcement transported both Underdahl and Frederick to detox facilities. Accordingly, the State request a Complaint Warrant.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
