COMPLAINT

Summons

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Possession or Sale of Stolen or Counterfeit Check; Crimes

Minnesota Statute: 609.528.2, with reference to: 609.52.3(3)(c)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years or \$10,000 fine

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 12/29/2025

Control #(ICR#): 26001416

Charge Description: On or about December 29, 2025, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Marissa Marie Rollings, did sell, possess, receive, or transfer a check that was stolen or counterfeit, knowing or having reason to know the check was stolen or counterfeit; and the offense involved two or three direct victims or the total, combined loss to the direct and indirect victims is more than \$500.00 but not more than \$2,500.00.

COUNT II

Charge: Identity Theft-Transfers/Possesses/Uses Identity of Other Person

Minnesota Statute: 609.527.2, with reference to: 609.52.3(3)(c)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years or \$10,000 fine

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 12/29/2025

Control #(ICR#): 26001416

Charge Description: On or about December 29, 2025, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Marissa Marie Rollings did transfer, possess or use an identity that is not the person's own, with the intent to commit, aid, or abet any unlawful activity and the offense involves two or three direct victims or the total, combined loss to the direct and indirect victims is more than \$500.00 but not more than \$2,500.00.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On January 14, 2026, Officer Mathiowetz of the Mankato Department of Public Safety received a referral from the North Mankato Police Department.

Officer Mathiowetz learned that on December 29, 2025, an individual later identified as Marissa Marie Rollings (DOB: 11/19/1999), went to Business 1 in the City of Mankato and cashed a fraudulent check for \$1,000.

Victim 1 filed an Affidavit of Notice of Fictitious Check with Business 1 explaining that he did not approve the check and that it was fraudulent.

North Mankato Police Officers discovered the fraudulent check when they responded to a North Mankato branch of Business 1 when Rollings attempted to cash a second check from the same account at that location.

Rollings admitted to using another individual's driver's license and social security card to cash the check, but claimed that individual sent her to Business 1 and that the checks were real.

Officers compared the checks that Rollings attempted to cash with checks typically drawn from the account and determined the checks were fraudulent. The checks appeared to have been created using account information from Victim 1.

Victim 1 stated he wrote a check using the check number found on the fraudulent check to a different individual and caused it to be mailed. The proper recipient never received the legitimate check and the payee's name was different.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
