COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Assault-2nd Degree-Dangerous Weapon

Minnesota Statute: 609.222.1, with reference to: 609.11.4

Maximum Sentence: 7 years or \$14,000 fine or both.

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 06/24/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26019650

Charge Description: On or about June 24, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Breanna Kay Anderson, did assault another with a dangerous weapon.

COUNT II

Charge: Threats of Violence-Reckless Disregard Risk

Minnesota Statute: 609.713.1

Maximum Sentence: 5 years or \$10,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 06/24/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26019650

Charge Description: On or about June 24, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Breanna Kay Anderson, did, threaten, directly or indirectly, to commit any crime of violence with purpose to terrorize another, or in a reckless disregard of the risk of causing such terror.

COUNT III

Charge: Domestic Assault-Misdemeanor-Commits Act to Cause Fear of Immediate Bodily Harm or Death

Minnesota Statute: 609.2242.1(1)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days or \$1,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 06/24/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26019650

Charge Description: On or about June 24, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Breanna Kay Anderson, did, against a family or household member, as defined in M.S.A. 518B.01 Subd. 2, commit an act with intent to cause fear in another of immediate bodily harm or death.

COUNT IV

Charge: Domestic Assault-Misdemeanor-Intentionally Inflicts/Attempts to Inflict Bodily Harm on Another

Minnesota Statute: 609.2242.1(2)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days or \$1,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 06/24/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26019650

Charge Description: On or about June 24, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Breanna Kay Anderson, did, against a family or household member, as defined in M.S.A. 518B.01 Subd. 2, intentionally inflict or attempt to inflict bodily harm upon another.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On June 24, 2026, officers of the Mankato Department of Public Safety were dispatched to a residence in Mankato, Minnesota, Blue Earth County, on report of a domestic incident. Specifically, Victim 1 called 911 and stated that his wife, Breanna Kay Anderson (dob 11/21/1994), tried to kill him with a steak knife and threatened to kill him.

Officers arrived and made contact with Victim 1 and Anderson. Victim 1 stated that an argument occurred and Anderson began to physically hurt Victim 1 by grabbing his beard and scratching the back of his neck. Victim 1 stated that Anderson later started knocking things over and eventually grabbed a butcher knife and held it to his throat. Victim 1 stated that Anderson told him, "I'll kill you." Victim 1 stated he was able to push past Anderson. Anderson then held the knife to her own throat and threatened to kill herself. Victim 1 fled the residence for his safety.

Anderson admitted to holding the knife to her throat but denied threatening Victim 1 with the knife.

Anderson was taken to the hospital for an evaluation. Anderson was cleared by the hospital and brought to jail.

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
