COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Dangerous Weapons-Reckless Discharge of Firearm Within a Municipality

Minnesota Statute: 609.66.1a(a)(3), with reference to: 609.66.1a(b)(2)

Maximum Sentence: 2 years or \$5,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 08/12/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26025412

Charge Description: On or about August 12, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Altravien Zakedrian James Eaglin did recklessly discharge a firearm within a municipality.

COUNT II

Charge: Possess Ammo/Any Firearm - Confined/Incompetent Mentally III

Minnesota Statute: 624.713.1(3), with reference to: 624.713.2(c)

Maximum Sentence: 364 days in jail or a \$3,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 08/12/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26025412

Charge Description: On or about August 12, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Altravien Zakedrian James Eaglin did possess a firearm or ammunition after being found not guilty by reason of mental illness.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On August 12, 2026, officers of the Mankato Department of Public Safety were dispatched to an apartment complex in Mankato, Minnesota, Blue Earth County, on report by Witness 1 that a gun went off in the apartment above his. Witness 1 said a male, later identified as Altravien Zakedrian James Eaglin, came down to his apartment and stated he got robbed.

Numerous officers urgently responded to the scene. Officers made contact with Witness 1 and Witness 2. Officers also made contact with Eaglin.

Witness 1 and Witness 2 provided statements that they were in their apartment below Eaglin's apartment. They then heard a loud bang and a bullet passed through the ceiling above them into their floor. Witness 1 and 2 stated that Eaglin then came down to their apartment and stated that he was robbed. Eaglin told Witness 1 and Witness 2 not to call police. Witness 1 and 2 eventually called police about what had occurred.

Eaglin made various statements indicating he had been robbed and then a firearm had been discharged. Officers executed a warrant on Eaglin's apartment and found a shell casing and one black glove. Officers later found an AR style rifle in the common laundry area that was wrapped in a rain jacket. A loaded rifle magazine containing 5.56 ammunition was on the floor next to the rifle. There was also a black glove near the gun.

Eaglin gave various statements about what occurred. At first, Eaglin claimed that it was not his gun that was discharged and he was not supposed to be around guns. Eventually, Eaglin stated that he was going to be honest and it was his gun and that he discharged it when he was taking the bullets out of the gun. Eaglin apologized for lying.

On May 13, 2026, in court file 07-CR-24-3271, Eaglin was found not guilty on the basis of mental illness by Judge Lieser on five counts of threats of violence.

(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
