The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Damage to Property - 1st Degree - Value Reduced Over \$1000

Minnesota Statute: 609.595.1(4)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years or \$10,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 12/26/2025

Control #(ICR#): 25036623

Charge Description: On or about December 26, 2025, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Jose Jesus Vasquez Mata did intentionally cause damage to another person's physical property without the other person's consent, and the damage reduced the value of the property by more than \$1,000.00, as measured by the cost of repair and replacement.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

In the morning on December 26, 2025, Officers from the Mankato Department of Public Safety were dispatched to Business 1 in the City of Mankato, Blue Earth County, following a report a patient there had damaged property and was threatening to harm people present. Security at Business 1 advised they were preparing to tase the patient, later identified as Jose Jesus Vasquez Mata (DOB: 02/19/2003). At Business 1, Officer Cogswell observed a door with a shattered window and that Mata's knuckles were bloody. Witness 1, an employee at Business 1, said Mata punched the glass and damaged it. The estimated cost to repair or replace the damaged window in the door is more than \$1,000.00.
