The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Stalking - Engages in Stalking

Minnesota Statute: 609.749.5(a), with reference to: 609.749.5(a)

Maximum Sentence: 10 years, or \$20,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 03/06/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26007060

Charge Description: On or about March 6, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Shea Patrick Kelly, did engaged in stalking with respect to a single victim or one or more members of a single household which the actor knows or has reason to know would cause the victim under the circumstances to feel terrorized or to fear bodily harm and which does cause this reaction on the part of the victim, is guilty of a felony and may be sentenced to imprisonment for not more than ten years or to payment of a fine of not more than \$20,000, or both.

COUNT II

Charge: Domestic Abuse No Contact Order - Violate No Contact Order - within 10 years of previous conviction

Minnesota Statute: 629.75.2(c), with reference to: 629.75.2(c)

Maximum Sentence: 10 days to 364 days or \$3,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 03/06/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26007060

Charge Description: On or about March 6, 2026 at, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Shea Patrick Kelly did violate a Domestic Abuse No-Contact Order and the respondent or person to be restrained knew of the existence of the order and the violation occurred within ten years of a previous qualified domestic

violence-related offense conviction or adjudication of delinquency.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On March 8, 2026, Victim called 911 to report that her estranged husband Shea Patrick Kelly (05/25/1971) had contacted her via telephone while she was at her residence in Mankato, Minnesota which is located in the County of Blue Earth. Victim indicated that this is in violation of a Domestic Abuse No Contact Order (DANCO) that was issued in relation to a separate court file dated October 29, 2025, and signed by the Honorable Judge Gregory Anderson. On March 6, 2026, Victim received a phone call from a phone number associated with a Clinic in Hibbing, Minnesota. Victim answered the phone number and asked who was calling. Victim recognized Kelly's voice, say "your husband."

Victim stated that Kelly said he wanted to talk to her about his treatment. Kelly described having been placed on a transport hold in Rochester and then transferred to a clinic in Hibbing after an altercation with a roommate at the Teen Challenge treatment center in Rochester. Kelly also asked about his 401k check, which is topic that led to a previous DANCO violation. Victim indicated that she allowed the conversation to continue for approximately 15 minutes so she could figure out where he currently was. Victim was able to provide screenshots of the call log and text messages she had received.

Victim stated that she is concerned for her safety because she expects Kelly to be served with divorce papers in the near future. Kelly has been kicked out of treatment recently due to threatening bodily harm on other patients. His whereabouts are currently uncertain.

The following are incidents involving Victim and Kelly which have resulted in them being criminally charged and or convicted:

7/2/2022-Kelly discharged a firearm during a domestic disturbance with Victim. Resulting in a Felony Conviction.

7/4/2025-Kelly charged with domestic assault after causing Victim to be fearful of bodily harm

8/29/2025-Kelly arrested after causing Victim to be fearful of bodily harm

01/14/2026-Kelly is convicted of misdemeanor Domestic Assault

02/04/2026-Kelly is charged with Domestic Abuse No Contact Order.

3/06/2026-Kelly calls Victim, which is a violation of the DANCO

Due to Kelly continuously violating a Court Ordered DANCO and the history of violence between Kelly and Victim there is a substantial likelihood for this behavior to continue it is appropriate for an Arrest Warrant to ensure Kelly's appearance and to prevent immediate harm to Victim.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
