The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNTI

Charge: Criminal Sexual Conduct - 3rd Degree - Penetration - Victim mentally impaired/physically helpless

Minnesota Statute: 609.344.1(b), with reference to: 609.344.2(1)

Maximum Sentence: 15 Years or \$30,000 fine or both.

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 06/07/2025

Control #(ICR#): 25017698

Charge Description: On or about June 7, 2025, in Blue Earth County, Minnesota, Antoine Deon Gater Williams Jr engaged in sexual penetration with another person, knowing or having reason to know that the victim was mentally impaired, mentally incapacitated, or physically helpless.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On June 21, 2025, at approximately 11:30 AM, Victim 1 came to the Public Safety Center with her stepmother, Witness 1, to report that Victim 1 had been sexually assaulted by Antoine Dion Gater Williams, Jr.

Ofc. Wayne Terry, with the Mankato Department of Public Safety, met with Victim 1 and took a statement from her. Victim 1 reported that she had been sexually assaulted while she was unconscious. Victim 1 believed the suspect to be Williams.

Victim 1 stated that on June 6, 2025, she and her roommate, Witness 2, went to the bars in downtown Mankato. They were with Witness 2 who is Witness 1's boyfriend. Victim 1 reported that she had multiple drinks and a few hits off of a marijuana vape while at the bars. At some point Williams joined the group.

Victim 1 stated that approximately 12:37 AM, she texted a friend to meet them at the bars. Victim 1 stated that approximately 10 minutes later her recollection of the events became vague. Victim 1 told officer Terry that the next thing she remembers was laying on her back in her bed and, "being fucked." Victim 1 stated she was already passed out when she regained consciousness she felt a penis inside of her.

Victim 1 stated she was not able to move and felt like her whole body was numb. Victim 1 stated that she felt paralyzed. Victim 1 stated she then lost consciousness again and passed out during the sexual assault.

Ofc. Terry asked Victim 1 if she was capable of getting up and getting away and she responded that she is only 83 pounds and that Williams has, "like 200 pounds on me," and, "I know he is a dangerous person." Victim 1 stated she had no memory of leaving the bar, going home, getting home or how she got into bed.

Victim 1 stated that she knew Williams from high school and had seen him downtown but that he is not a person she would have a romantic interest in. Williams had been downtown with Victim 1 and her friends as Victim 1 was drinking.

Ofc. Terry spoke with several witnesses, including Witness 3. Witness 3 stated that he drove Victim 1 home and carried her upstairs and laid her on her bed. Witness 3 stated that when he went back downstairs Williams was inside Victim 1's residence and waiting at the bottom of the stairs. Witness 3 stated he saw Williams go upstairs to Victim 1's bedroom.

Victim 1 provided Officer Terry with clothing that she was wearing on the night of the assault. Victim 1 had a sexual assault exam on June 21, 2025.

Detective William Hullopeter took over the investigation from Ofc. Terry. Detective Hullopeter drafted a search warrant for a sample of Williams DNA. The search warrant was reviewed and signed by Judge of the Fifth Judicial District. The DNA sample collected from Williams was sent to the BCA. Williams DNA profile matched the DNA taken from a pair of underwear that Victim 1 had worn the night of the sexual assault.

On July 2, 2025, Detective Hullopeter interviewed Williams. Williams admitted that approximately one month prior he was in the downtown entertainment district in the City of Mankato. Williams stated that he had gone back to Victim 1's residence and that Victim 1 had led him by the hand upstairs to her bedroom. Williams stated that he had sexual intercourse with Victim 1 but that he stopped at some point because he felt guilty as he had a girlfriend and a child at home.

Williams is currently in custody at the Blue Earth County Jail on an unrelated matter. A warrant for his arrest is requested.
