The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNTI

Charge: Harassment; Restraining Order - Violate Restraining Order

Minnesota Statute: 609.748.6(a)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days or \$1,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 12/16/2025

Control #(ICR#): 25002287

Charge Description: On or about December 16, 2025, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Zachary Hugh Ertman did violate a restraining order issued under M.S. 609.748.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On December 16, 2025 at approximately 11:09 pm, Mapleton Police Officer Guillemette was dispatched to a call for service at a residence in the City of Mapleton. The call for service residence shares a driveway with a "Protected Person" known to the Officer to have an active Harassment Restraining Order (HRO) relating to Zachary Hugh Ertman, DOB: 07/10/1990. Upon arriving at the initial call for service location, Officer Guillemette observed Ertman's vehicle parked in front of the Protected Person's residence. The Officer was aware that there was a HRO that prohibited Ertman from being within 100 feet of the Protected Person's address. Mapleton Police Chief Honsey had been called for a violation of the same HRO on December 7, 2025.

After finishing with the initial, unrelated call for service, Officer Guillemette knocked on the Protected Person's door to check on her safety. The Protected Person denied that Ertman was present at the residence. When asked about Ertman's vehicle being at the location, the Protected Person explained that she has been using the vehicle. The Officer requested permission to check the residence for Ertman, but the Protected Person denied the request. Blue Earth County Sheriff's Deputy was on scene and indicated that Ertman's vehicle had been observed by law enforcement that day at his grandmother's residence, where he resides. With this additional information, Officer Guillemette returned to the Protected Person's residence.

Officer Guillemette returned to the Protected Person's residence, as the details provided by the Blue Earth County Sheriff's Deputy did not line up with the Protected Person's explanation. The Protected Person's explanations and subsequent denial that Ertman was in her home, did not appear to be truthful to Officer Guillemette. After approximately forty (40) minutes of discussion with the Protected Person and law enforcement, Ertman emerged from the residence and was cooperative with law enforcement.

Officer Guillemette verified that the Harassment Restraining Order in Court File No.: 07-CV-25-2752 was active and verified that paragraph 1 (c) of the Order prohibited Ertman from being within 100 feet of the Protected Person's address. Ertman was personally served with the Harassment Restraining Order on July 17, 2025.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:

(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or

(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
