The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Threats of Violence-Reckless Disregard Risk

Minnesota Statute: 609.713.1

Maximum Sentence: 5 years or \$10,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 05/29/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26016556

Charge Description: On or about May 29, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Addison Marie Hammon, did, threaten, directly or indirectly, to commit any crime of violence with purpose to terrorize another, or in a reckless disregard of the risk of causing such terror.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On May 29, 2026, at approximately 4 AM, officers of Mankato Department of Public Safety were dispatched to the top of the parking ramp on report that Addison Marie Hammon (dob 08/13/2007) was threatening to stab Victim 1.

Officers arrived and made contact with Hammon and Victim 1. Hammon was making comments about protecting her siblings but not knowing where they were. Hammon was intoxicated.

Officers spoke with Victim 1. Victim 1 stated that Hammon and him got a ride back to the parking ramp. While in the car, Hammon started making comments about stabbing him. Once at the parking ramp, Hammon became verbally aggressive and started yelling at him. Victim 1 stated Hammon stated that she was going to stab him with a knife in her vehicle. Hammon then went into her vehicle while still making threats to Victim 1. Victim 1 believed Hammon was searching for a weapon in her vehicle. Victim 1 was terrified that he was going to be harmed so he called law enforcement.

Officers found a knife in Hammon's vehicle.

Hammon was taken to a detoxification facility. A warrant is requested.

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
