COMPLAINT

Summons

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Mail Theft-Intentionally Removes Mail from Depository without Claim of Right

Minnesota Statute: 609.529.2(1), with reference to: 609.529.3

Maximum Sentence: 3 years or \$5,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 05/10/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26015420

Charge Description: On or about May 10, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Milena Shaye Green, did, intentionally and without claim of right removed mail from a mail depository.

COUNT II

Charge: Mail Theft-Intentionally takes Mail Left for Collection without Claim of Right

Minnesota Statute: 609.529.2(5), with reference to: 609.529.3

Maximum Sentence: 3 years or \$5,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 05/10/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26015420

Charge Description: On or about May 10, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Milena Shaye Green, did intentionally and without claim of right takes mail, or the contents of mail, that has been left for collection on or near a mail depository.

COUNT III

Charge: Theft-Take/Use/Transfer Movable Prop-No Consent

Minnesota Statute: 609.52.2(a)(1), with reference to: 609.52.3(5)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days or \$1,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 05/10/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26015420

Charge Description: On or about May 10, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Milena Shaye Green did, intentionally and without claim of right, take, use, transfer, conceal or retain possession of the movable property of another without the other's consent and with intent to deprive the owner permanently of possession of the property.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On May 19, 2026, Officer Christ of the Mankato Department of Public Safety responded to a report of a theft of mail from a residential complex within the City of Mankato. Officer Christ was informed that a package had been stolen from the mail room by a DoorDash driver (later identified as Milena Shaye Green – DOB: 12/22/1999) and that the package was delivered on May 10, 2026.

Officer Christ spoke with Victim 1 who stated that they had ordered a package from Amazon. The package had been delivered to the mail depository room of her residential complex. Victim 1 stated that the package had been left on top of the mail collection boxes that are present just inside the door of the residential complex. Victim 1 stated that Green did not have permission to take the package. The contents of the package were valued at less than \$500.

Officer Christ also spoke with Witness 1, who is the property manager for the residential complex. Witness 1 provided Officer Christ with security camera footage from the residential complex. Witness 1 also informed Officer Christ that the package was placed on the mail collection boxes within the building. Witness 1 told Officer Christ that Green entered the residential complex to deliver bags of food then, while on the way out of the building, Green took Victim 1's mail/package from the top of the mail collection boxes and left.

In viewing the security footage, Officer Christ was able to identify the vehicle Green drove away in. Officer Christ was also able to view the video of Green taking Victim 1's mail/package from the mail area and leaving the area with it.

Officer Christ spoke with Green, who confirmed that Green had previously worked as a DoorDasher. Green also confirmed that she had DoorDashed items to the residential complex around the time of when this incident occurred.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
