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**COMPLAINT**

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I**

**Charge: Emergency Telephone Calls/Communications - Interrupt, Interfere, Impede, Disrupt 911 Call**

Minnesota Statute: 609.78.2(1)

Maximum Sentence: 364 days or \$3,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 05/17/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26010358

Charge Description: On or about May 17, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Rebecca Estelle Eisel did and intentionally interrupt, disrupt, impede, or interfere with an emergency call or intentionally prevent or hinder another from placing an emergency call.

**COUNT II**

**Charge: Domestic Assault-Misdemeanor-Commits Act to Cause Fear of Immediate Bodily Harm or Death**

Minnesota Statute: 609.2242.1(1)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days or \$1,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 05/17/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26010358

Charge Description: On or about May 17, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Rebecca Estelle Eisel, did, against a family or household member, as defined in M.S.A. 518B.01 Subd. 2, commit an act with intent to cause fear in another of immediate bodily harm or death.

## STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On May 17, 2026, Law Enforcement was called to a domestic situation within the County of Blue Earth. Deputy Mark Purvis of the Blue Earth County Sheriff's Office responded and spoke to Victim and Witness 1. Victim was calling regarding their adult daughter Rebecca Estelle Eisel (DOB 8-15-1991) who had just recently moved in. Victim stated that Eisel was yelling and using bad language towards her. Law enforcement spoke to Eisel and Eisel indicated that she moved in approximately three weeks prior and has been paying rent. Eisel conveyed that she did not have any other viable places to stay at the moment. Law enforcement did not remove Eisel from the home at that time and provided Victim and Witness 1 regarding the eviction process. Victim was upset at this result.

Deputy Purvis left the property and parked in Lake Crystal to enter notes regarding the incident he had just responded to. While entering notes Deputy Purvis was dispatched to the same location he had just left. Upon arrival he spoke with Victim, Eisel, and Witness 1 again. Victim 1 indicated that another fight ensued. Victim stated that she was trying to eat and while doing so Eisel became angry and Eisel grabbed the center island and broke it away from the floor. During that fight Eisel had pushed Victim against a wall and while calling 911 Eisel had taken Victim's phone. Victim indicated that she was on the line with 911 when Eisel had taken the phone.

Eisel stated that she knew that Victim was on the phone with 911 when she took the phone from Victim. Victim indicated that Eisel's behavior put in fear for her safety. Eisel was arrested and transported to the Blue Earth County Jail.

## SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:  
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or  
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
