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The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I**

**Charge: Domestic Assault-GM-Subsequent Violation**

Minnesota Statute: 609.2242.2

Maximum Sentence: 364 days or \$3,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 05/31/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26016901

Charge Description: On or about May 31, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Amber Rae Murilla, did, against a family or household member, as defined in M.S.A. 518B.01 Subd. 2, intentionally inflicted or attempted to inflict bodily harm upon another and has a previous qualified domestic violence-related offense conviction or an adjudication of delinquency within ten years.

## STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On May 31, 2026, officers of the Mankato Department of Public Safety were dispatched regarding a domestic incident that occurred in Mankato, Minnesota, Blue Earth County.

Officers went to the area and made contact with Victim 1 who was walking. Officers also went to the residence and made contact with Amber Rae Murilla. Murilla claimed nothing happened.

Victim 1 said he was assaulted by Murilla. Victim 1 said he has been in an on and off again romantic relationship with Murilla for approximately ten years. Victim 1 stated he was over at Murilla's residence and a verbal argument started. Murilla then dumped out one of his bags with his belongings. Murilla then struck Victim 1 in the face and head.

Sergeant Wood observed injuries consistent with what Victim 1 described.

Victim 1 stated Murilla grabbed a knife that fell from his belongings. Victim 1 stated he grabbed a hold of Murilla's arms to control her and Murilla himself because he was afraid Murilla may use a knife to harm him.

Murilla was arrested. Murilla then claimed she was a victim and said she lied when she told law enforcement nothing happened. Murilla's story was not consistent with the injuries observed on Victim 1.

Murilla has a previous assault conviction from 2022 in 66-CR-20-2408.
