The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Liquor-Lend/Permit use of driver's license or ID to under 21 yr for purchase

Minnesota Statute: 340A.503.2(3), with reference to: 340A.702(8)

Maximum Sentence: 364 days jail, \$3,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 03/20/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26008402

Charge Description: On or about March 20, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Alexa Annmarie Vukich, did induce a person under the age of 21 years to purchase or procure any alcoholic beverage, or did lend or knowingly permit the use of the person's driver's license, permit, Minnesota identification card, or other form of identification by a person under the age of 21 years for the purpose of purchasing or attempting to purchase an alcoholic beverage.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Around 10:30 p.m. on Friday, March 20, 2026, Officer Hickey from Mankato Department of Public Safety was advised by a female claiming to be 22-years-old that a bouncer at Business 1 in the City of Mankato took the female's ID. Officer Wagner spoke with bouncers at Business 1 who provided Wagner with a real ID belonging to Alexa Annmarie Vukich (DOB: 11/22/2003).

They advised they took Vukich's ID after seeing it used by two different people to enter Business 1 in a short amount of time. Business 1 does not allow anyone under 21 to enter Business 1 at that time on a Friday night. Vukich admitted to Officer Wagner that Vukich allowed Vukich's friend, Witness 1, age 20, to use Vukich's ID to enter Business 1. Witness 1 submitted to a portable breath test that returned a result of 0.114.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
