COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Threats of Violence-Reckless Disregard Risk

Minnesota Statute: 609.713.1

Maximum Sentence: 5 years or \$10,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 09/07/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26028841

Charge Description: On or about September 7, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Jacob Allen Adams, did, threaten, directly or indirectly, to commit any crime of violence with purpose to terrorize another, or in a reckless disregard of the risk of causing such terror.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On September 7, 2026, Officer McGuire of the Mankato Department of Public Safety was dispatched to a report of someone threatening to kill another individual within the City of Mankato. Officer McGuire contacted an individual, Witness 1, who stated that Jacob Allen Adams (DOB: 03/10/1991) had threatened to kill his girlfriend, Victim 1.

Witness 1 told Officer McGuire that he and Adams had been in a significant romantic relationship previously but that that relationship had ended. Witness 1 stated that he had since began a romantic relationship with Victim 1. Witness 1 reported that Adams had threatened to kill Victim 1. Victim 1 told Officer McGuire that she was still physically shaking and afraid several hours after Adams had threatened to kill her.

Adams also sent a threatening text message to Witness 2, who is a close friend of Witness 1, about killing Victim 1. The text message from Adams to Witness 2 told Witness 2 to tell Witness 1 and Victim 1 that Adams was going to stab Victim 1 to death.

Due to the multiple threats against her life by Adams, Victim 1 was afraid for her safety.

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
