**COMPLAINT**

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I**

**Charge: Assault - 4th Degree - Peace Officer - Demonstrable bodily harm**

Minnesota Statute: 609.2231.1(c)(1)

Maximum Sentence: 3 years or \$6,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 09/20/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26030363

Charge Description: On or about September 20, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Sharon Bosibori Nyaume did physically assault and inflict demonstrable bodily harm upon a peace officer licensed under state law who was effecting a lawful arrest or executing any other duty imposed by law.

**COUNT II**

**Charge: Damage to Property - 1st Degree - Value Reduced Over \$1000**

Minnesota Statute: 609.595.1(4)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years or \$10,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 09/20/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26030363

Charge Description: On or about September 20, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Sharon Bosibori Nyaume did intentionally cause damage to another person's physical property without the other person's consent, and the damage reduced the value of the property by more than \$1,000.00, as measured by the cost of repair and replacement.

**COUNT III**

**Charge: Emergency Telephone Calls/Communications - Interrupt, Interfere, Impede, Disrupt 911**

Charge Description: On or about September 20, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Sharon Bosibori Nyaume did intentionally interrupt, disrupt, impede, or interfere with an emergency call or intentionally prevent or hinder another from placing an emergency call.

**COUNT IV****Charge: Obstruct Legal Process-Interfere w/Peace Officer**

Minnesota Statute: 609.50.1(2), with reference to: 609.50.2(2)

Maximum Sentence: 364 days or \$3,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 09/20/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26030363

Charge Description: On or about September 20, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Sharon Bosibori Nyaume did, intentionally, obstruct, resist, or interfere with a peace officer while the officer was engaged in the performance of official duties and the act was accompanied by force or violence or the threat thereof.

**COUNT V****Charge: Assault in the fifth degree; Gross misdemeanor-Within three years of previous conviction.**

Minnesota Statute: 609.224.2(b)

Maximum Sentence: 364 days or \$3,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 09/20/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26030363

Charge Description: On or about September 20, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Sharon Bosibori Nyaume, did intentionally inflict or attempt to inflict bodily harm upon another within three years of a previous qualified domestic violence-related offense conviction or adjudication of delinquency.

## STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

In the evening on September 20, 2026, Officers from the Mankato Department of Public Safety responded to an assault complaint in Blue Earth County. Officers went to a residence and spoke with Victim 1. Victim 1 said Sharon Bosibori Nyaume (DOB: 04/14/1998) threw Victim 1's cell phone against the wall during a verbal altercation. Victim 1 reported Nyaume also shoved Victim 1 against a wall. When Victim 1 tried to remove Nyaume from the location where they were, Nyaume began punching Victim 1 in the face and chest. Victim 1 estimated Nyaume punched Victim 1 with a closed fist approximately 20 times. After Victim 1 called 911, Nyaume bit Victim 1's phone, making it inoperable and preventing Victim 1 from speaking with Blue Earth County Dispatch. Victim 1 reported the value of Victim 1's phone is \$1,200. Victim 1 said Nyaume then pushed Victim 1 over the side of a porch, causing Victim 1 to fall to the ground and hit her head. Officer Wright observed severe damage to Victim 1's phone.

When Officer Kratovil arrived to the residence, Nyaume was inside. Kratovil instructed Nyaume multiple times to exit the residence so he could speak with her about the incident, but she refused to follow his instructions. Ultimately, Nyaume was placed in handcuffs and escorted out of the residence by two officers because she would not comply with their instructions and she physically resisted their efforts to accompany Nyaume outside so they could investigate the reported incident. Because of Nyaume's obstructive conduct, Officers decided to direct Nyaume to the ground in a controlled manner, to prevent a standing fight and ensure everyone's safety.

When Nyaume was escorted to a squad car, she continued trying to pull away from Officers and remaining noncompliant with their instructions.

Victim 1 told Officer Kratovil that Nyaume had been intoxicated all day and harassing Victim 1.

Officer Kratovil spoke with Witness 1 at the residence, who said Nyaume had been agitated all day and trying to pick a fight with Victim 1. According to Witness 1, Victim 1 and Witness 1 asked Nyaume multiple times to leave the residence where they all were, but Nyaume refused. Witness 1 observed Nyaume punch Victim 1 in the face and chest with a closed fist approximately 20 times. Witness 1 said when Victim 1 tried to call 911, Nyaume took Victim 1's phone and bit it, breaking the phone. Witness 1 saw Nyaume push Victim 1 over the banister on the porch, causing Victim 1 to fall to the ground and hit her head.

Nyaume was arrested and transported to the Blue Earth County Jail. At the Jail, Nyaume continued to physically resist. While Officers escorted Nyaume inside the Jail, Nyaume kicked a Police Officer from the Mankato Department of Public Safety in the groin. The kick caused the Officer pain and he was unable to continue to escort Nyaume as a result, letting go of Nyaume immediately.

Nyaume was convicted of Assault-5th Degree on January 27, 2025, in Court File No. 07-CR-24-1411.
