COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Traffic - DWI - Operate Motor Vehicle Under Influence of Alcohol

Minnesota Statute: 169A.20.1(1), with reference to: 169A.24.2

Maximum Sentence: 7 years or \$14,000 fine or both.

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 05/30/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26016696

Charge Description: On or about May 30, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Remy Tyrell Peterson, did, drive, operate, or was in physical control of any motor vehicle when he/she was under the influence of alcohol, and the violation was committed within ten years of the first of three or more qualified driving incidents or he/she has previously been convicted of felony D.W.I.

COUNT II

Charge: Traffic - DWI - Operate Motor Vehicle - Alcohol Concentration 0.08 Within 2 Hours

Minnesota Statute: 169A.20.1(5), with reference to: 169A.24.2

Maximum Sentence: 7 years or \$14,000 fine or both.

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 05/30/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26016696

Charge Description: On or about May 30, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Remy Tyrell Peterson, did, drive, operate, or was in physical control of any motor vehicle, when his/her alcohol concentration at the time, or as measured within two hours of the time, of driving, operating or being in physical control of the motor vehicle was 0.08 or more, and the violation was committed within ten years of the first of three or more qualified driving incidents or he/she has previously been convicted of felony D.W.I.

COUNT III

Charge: Burglary-1st Deg-Dwelling-Occupied-Non-Accomplice Present

Minnesota Statute: 609.582.1(a), with reference to: 609.582.1a

Maximum Sentence: 20 years or \$35,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 05/30/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26016696

Charge Description: On or about May 30, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Remy Tyrell Peterson did enter a building without consent and with intent to commit a crime, or entered a building without consent and committed a crime while in the building, either directly or as an accomplice and the building is a dwelling and another person, not an accomplice, is present in it when the burglar enters or at any time while the burglar is in the building.

COUNT IV

Charge: Theft-Take/Drive Motor Vehicle-No Owner Consent

Minnesota Statute: 609.52.2(a)(17), with reference to: 609.52.3(3)(d)(v)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years or \$10,000, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 05/30/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26016696

Charge Description: On or about May 30, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Remy Tyrell Peterson did take or drive a motor vehicle without the consent of the owner or an authorized agent of the owner, knowing or having reason to know that the owner or authorized agent did not give consent.

COUNT V

Charge: Receiving Stolen Property

Minnesota Statute: 609.53.1, with reference to: 609.52.3(3)(d)(v)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years or \$10,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 05/30/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26016696

Charge Description: On or about May 30, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Remy Tyrell Peterson did receive, possess, transfer, buy or conceal any stolen property or property obtained by robbery, knowing or having reason to know the property was stolen or obtained by robbery and the property is a motor vehicle.

COUNT VI

Charge: Damage to Property - 3rd Degree - Reduce Value \$501-\$1000

Minnesota Statute: 609.595.2(a)(1)

Maximum Sentence: 364 days or \$3,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 05/30/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26016696

Charge Description: On or about May 30, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Remy Tyrell Peterson did intentionally cause damage to another person's physical property without the other person's consent, and the damage reduced the value of the property by more than \$500.00 but no more than \$1,000.00 as measured by the cost of repair and replacement.

COUNT VII

Charge: Trespass-Occupy/Enter Dwelling/Locked/Posted Build

Minnesota Statute: 609.605.1(b)(4)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days or \$1,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 05/30/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26016696

Charge Description: On or about May 30, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Remy Tyrell Peterson did occupy or enter the dwelling or locked or posted building of another, without claim of right or consent of the owner or the consent of one who has the right to give consent, except in an emergency situation.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On May 30, 2026, at approximately 5:38 AM, Blue Earth County dispatch received a 911 call from Victim 1. Victim 1 explained that there was someone that broke into her attached porch. Victim 1 stated that the suspect was grunting and moaning and possibly on drugs.

Officers arrived at the residence and noticed that the storm door for the porch was closed but the glass for the storm door was broken. Officers observed an individual inside the porch holding the glass panel from the door. The individual was detained and later identified as Remy Tyrell Peterson, dob 1/23/1998.

Officers smelled a strong odor of consumed alcoholic beverages coming from Peterson. Peterson also had bloodshot and glassy eyes. Peterson admitted to drinking but claimed he had just shown up in an Uber and thought it was his house.

Victim 1 said she was sleeping and woke up to a loud bang on the porch. Victim 1 observed a male in her locked porch area.

There was damage to the door which was estimated to cost over \$500 to repair.

Nearby, officers observed a vehicle with the door open that appeared to be abandoned. Inside the vehicle, Officer Gelle found Peterson's wallet. The vehicle was previously reported to have been stolen. Officer Gelle observed that the ignition was fully punched out of the vehicle and there were tools on the floorboard. Officers also found a pair of glasses by the vehicle, which Peterson confirmed were his.

Officers observed signs of impairment when administering the horizontal gaze nystagmus to Peterson. Peterson later provided a breath test which had a reported value of .16.

Peterson has a prior DWI conviction in 2025 in court file number 07-CR-25-2522, a prior DWI conviction in 2019 in court file number 07-CR-18-4265, and a prior DWI revocation from November 2021.

Peterson's license is cancelled as inimical to public safety.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
