The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I**

**Charge: Damage to Property - 1st Degree - Value Reduced Over \$1000**

Minnesota Statute: 609.595.1(4)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years or \$10,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 06/30/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26020314

Charge Description: On or about June 30, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Dolph Samuel Struck did intentionally cause damage to another person's physical property without the other person's consent, and the damage reduced the value of the property by more than \$1,000.00, as measured by the cost of repair and replacement.

## STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

In the afternoon on June 30, 2026, Witness 1 reported to police that a man threw a rock at a television in the lobby of Business 1 in Blue Earth County. Witness 2 reported the television, valued at \$1,800, was broken as a result and needed to be replaced. Witnesses reported the man who threw the rock then left Business 1 and walked over to the front lawn of the Intergovernmental Center in the City of Mankato. Witnesses provided a description of the man.

Sergeant Gilbertson from the Mankato Department of Public Safety reviewed Milestone camera footage of the incident and confirmed the male who had broken the television was the same male sitting at a picnic table smoking a cigarette in front of the Intergovernmental Center. Sergeant Gilbertson and Officer Christianson went to that location and made contact with the man, identified as Dolph Samuel Struck (DOB: 04/26/1995), placing Struck under arrest.

Officers searched Struck incident to arrest and found multiple rocks on Struck's person.

Sergeant Gilbertson observed the television had a large crack in the screen and around the bottom of its frame.

On June 27, 2026, Struck was arrested after witnesses observed him cause approximately \$1000 in damage to two vehicles in Blue Earth County by throwing rocks at them.

## SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:  
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or  
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
