The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I**

**Charge: Drugs - 5th Degree - Possess Schedule 1,2,3,4 or paraphernalia residual - Not cannabis/hemp**

Minnesota Statute: 152.025.2(a)(1), with reference to: 152.025.4(a)

Maximum Sentence: 364 days or \$3,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 05/09/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26014296

Charge Description: On or about May 9, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Willow Irene White, did, did unlawfully possess one or more mixtures containing a controlled substance classified in schedule I, II, III, or IV, except heroin or a small amount of marijuana, and the mixture does not include any amount of a controlled substance in a fluid used in a water pipe, and the weight of the substance is less than .25 grams or one dosage unit or less and the person has not been previously convicted of a violation of Chapter 152.

## STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On May 9, 2026, at 10:27 AM, Officer Pike of the Mankato Department of Public Safety was dispatched to a suspicious person complaint at Business 1 in the City of Mankato. Officer Pike arrived at the location and identified Witness 1 and Willow Irene White (DOB 5/5/2005). Both Witness 1 and White had active warrants for their arrest. White was searched incident to arrest and Office Pike located numerous items of drug paraphernalia, including a bubble pipe with a white crystal-like substance inside that field tested positive for methamphetamine and a small blue in color gem baggie containing a white crystal-like substance that field tested positive for methamphetamine and weighed .25 grams.
