**COMPLAINT**

Order of Detention

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

**COUNT I**

**Charge: Damage to Property - 1st Degree - Value Reduced Over \$1000**

Minnesota Statute: 609.595.1(4)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years or \$10,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 02/21/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26005330

Charge Description: On or about February 21, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Alex Michael Hanrahan did intentionally cause damage to another person's physical property without the other person's consent, and the damage reduced the value of the property by more than \$1,000.00, as measured by the cost of repair and replacement.

**COUNT II**

**Charge: Disorderly Conduct - Offensive/Abusive/Boisterous/Noisy/Obscene**

Minnesota Statute: 609.72.1(3)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days or \$1,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 02/21/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26005330

Charge Description: On or about February 21, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Alex Michael Hanrahan did, in a public or private place, including on a school bus, knowing, or having reasonable grounds to know it will, or will tend to, alarm, anger or disturb others or provoke an assault or breach of the peace, engaged in offensive, obscene, abusive, boisterous, or noisy conduct or in offensive, obscene, or abusive language tending reasonably to arouse alarm, anger, or resentment in others.

**COUNT III**

**Charge: Disruptive Intoxication - Mankato**

Local Code: 12-22(c)

Maximum Sentence: 90 days or \$1,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 02/21/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26005330

Charge Description: On or about On or about February 21, 2026, in the City of Mankato, in the County of Blue Earth, Alex Michael Hanrahan did, while intoxicated, conduct him or herself so as to be a danger to themselves or others and/or engage in public disruption.

## STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

In the middle of the night on February 21, 2026, officers from the Mankato Department of Public Safety were dispatched to a residence in the City of Mankato after Victim 1 reported a male had broken into Victim 1's backyard and was pounding on Victim 1's windows and kicking at Victim 1's glass patio door. Victim 1 provided a description of the male to Blue Earth County dispatch. Victim 1 reported Victim 1 fired one shot at the male with a Ruger SR22 .22 caliber handgun because Victim 1 was afraid the male was going to enter Victim 1's home.

Officer Keane went to the residence and immediately observed that Victim 1's vinyl fence had been ripped down and that a sliding glass door in the backyard had been shattered. Keane noticed a portion of the fence on another side of Victim 1's house had also been torn down. Keane observed footprints leading to Victim 1's backyard and to the next-door neighbor's yard, where Keane encountered a male with blood around his nose and on his clothes. The male was identified as Alex Michael Hanrahan (DOB: 12/08/2003). Hanrahan said he was ok and appeared not to realize Victim 1 had shot at Hanrahan.

Officer Pike spoke with Victim 1 who said Victim 1 captured the incident on camera surveillance at Victim 1's residence. Officer Pike reviewed the recording and saw Hanrahan on the outside of Victim 1's residence, covered in blood, kicking windows and doors before going to the patio door which Hanrahan also kicked. Following the sound of a gunshot, Hanrahan walked away from the patio door.

Hanrahan was transported to the Emergency Room at Mayo Clinic Health Services where staff discovered Hanrahan had a bullet in his face.

Hanrahan provided a preliminary breath test sample which yielded a result of .172.

Officer Pike spoke with Hanrahan following a Miranda warning. Hanrahan said he had several beers and five shots of whiskey while visiting a friend in the City of Mankato in the evening on February 20, 2026. Hanrahan claimed to have no memory of the evening after exiting a vehicle in downtown Mankato to go to the bars, before waking up in the back of an ambulance.

Victim 1 estimates it will cost \$3,000.00 to repair or replace the damage Hanrahan caused to Victim 1's vinyl fence.

## SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:  
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or  
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
