The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Threats of Violence-Reckless Disregard Risk

Minnesota Statute: 609.713.1

Maximum Sentence: 5 years or \$10,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 12/17/2025

Control #(ICR#): 25036076

Charge Description: On or about December 17, 2025, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Ayub O Haji Abdullahi, did, threaten, directly or indirectly, to commit any crime of violence with purpose to terrorize another, or in a reckless disregard of the risk of causing such terror.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On December 19, 2025, at approximately 3:56 PM, Officer John McGuire of the Mankato Department of Public Safety was dispatched to call the owner of a local pizza shop regarding a threat made by a customer. Ofc. McGuire called and spoke with Victim 1.

Victim 1 stated that on December 17, 2025, between the hours of 5:30 PM and 6:00 PM a male, who would later be identified as Ayub O. Haji Abdullahi, had come into the pizza shop and become upset because he did not have enough money to pay for his pizza.

Haji Abdullahi kept repeating that he was upset thinking that the pizza shop staff had, "called someone to mess with his vehicle." Before leaving the pizza shop, Haji Abdullahi shouted at Victim 1 that he was going to, "shoot this place up," and that he was, "armed and dangerous." The lobby of the pizza shop was crowded. Victim 1 provided a video clip of the incident; the video clip does not have audio.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
