COMPLAINT

Warrant

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Fleeing a Peace Officer in a Motor Vehicle

Minnesota Statute: 609.487.3

Maximum Sentence: 3 years and one day or \$5,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 06/16/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26018736

Charge Description: On or about June 16, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Mandi Marie Jablonski did by means of a motor vehicle, flee or attempt to flee a peace officer who is acting in the lawful discharge of an official duty, and the perpetrator knows or should reasonably know the same to be a peace officer.

COUNT II

Charge: Drugs - 3rd Degree - Possess - Methamphet/Amphetamine in School/Park/Pub Housing Zone

Minnesota Statute: 152.023.2(a)(6), with reference to: 152.023.3(a)

Maximum Sentence: 20 years or \$250,000, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 06/16/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26018736

Charge Description: On or about June 16, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Mandi Marie Jablonski did unlawfully possesses one or more mixtures containing methamphetamine or amphetamine in a school zone, a park zone, a public housing zone, or a drug treatment facility.

COUNT III

Charge: Drugs - 5th Degree - Possess Schedule 1,2,3,4 or paraphernalia residual - Not cannabis/hemp

Minnesota Statute: 152.025.2(a)(1), with reference to: 152.025.4(b)

Maximum Sentence: 5 years or \$10,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 06/16/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26018736

Charge Description: On or about June 16, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Mandi Marie Jablonski, did unlawfully possess one or more mixtures containing a controlled substance classified in schedule I, II, III, or IV, except cannabis flower, cannabis products, lower-potency hemp edibles, or hemp-derived consumer products or a residual amount of one or more mixtures of controlled substances contained in drug paraphernalia, and the mixture does not include any amount of a controlled substance in a fluid used in a water pipe and said controlled substance was more than .25 grams or 1 dosage unit.

COUNT IV

Charge: Traffic - DWI - Refuse to submit to chemical test; Blood or urine as required by search warrant

Minnesota Statute: 169A.20.2(2), with reference to: 169A.26.2

Maximum Sentence: 364 days or \$3,000 fine, or both

Offense Level: Gross Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 06/16/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26018736

Charge Description: On or about June 16, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Mandi Marie Jablonski, did, drive, operate, or was in physical control of any motor vehicle and the Defendant refused to submit to a chemical test of the person's blood or urine as required by a search warrant.

COUNT V

Charge: Traffic - DWI - Operate Motor Vehicle Under Influence of Controlled Substance

Minnesota Statute: 169A.20.1(2), with reference to: 169A.27.2

Maximum Sentence: 90 days or \$1,000 fine, or both.

Offense Level: Misdemeanor

Offense Date (on or about): 06/16/2026

Control #(ICR#): 26018736

Charge Description: On or about June 16, 2026, in the County of Blue Earth, Minnesota, Mandi Marie Jablonski, did, drive, operate, or was in physical control of any motor vehicle when he/she was under the influence of a controlled substance.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

On June 16, 2026, law enforcement responded to multiple driving complaints on Hoffman Road within the City of Mankato. Witness 1 called Blue Earth County Dispatch and stated that a Dark Blue Mazda was driving up-and-down Hoffman Road and repeatedly making illegal U-turns in the middle of the road. Witness 1 further stated that the vehicle was not speeding but was continuing to drive up-and-down Hoffman Road making illegal U-turns and swerving into oncoming lanes of traffic.

At the same time of Witness 1's phone call, Blue Earth County Dispatch also received a call from Witness 2 who stated that a Dark Blue Mazda driven by a female (later identified as Mandi Marie Jablonski DOB: 04/10/1985) was driving erratically on Hoffman Road near Mankato East High School. Witness 2 further reported that Jablonski stopped sideways in the roadway and was blocking both lanes of traffic near Thomas Drive.

Officer Christianson of the Mankato Department of Public Safety responded and located the vehicle driving on Hoffman Road near Mankato East High School. Officer Christianson identified the vehicle and license plate information, activated his emergency lights, and initiated a traffic stop. After stopping the vehicle Officer Christianson identified Jablonski as the driver and sole occupant of the vehicle. Officer Christianson noted that Jablonski appeared paranoid, sweating, and was not making sense when speaking with her.

Jablonski told Officer Christianson that she was trying to get to the gas station to fill her vehicle up and was worried that people would make fun of her chapped lips. Officer Christianson noted that Jablonski admitted to having consumed narcotics recently; Jablonski told Officer Christianson that she had done "a line" about 10 to 20 minutes prior to driving. Officer Christianson repeatedly commanded Jablonski to turn off the vehicle. Jablonski refused and began driving away as Officer Christianson was at the driver's side window of Jablonski's car.

Officer Christianson got back into his vehicle, activated his siren, and began pursuing the vehicle. The pursuit continued westbound on Hoffman Road at approximately 20 mph, in the westbound lane. Jablonski then conducted an illegal U-turn at the 2100 block of Hoffman Rd at a low speed. She then turned into the parking lot of Happy Dans, 2160 Hoffman Rd, at a low speed.

Officer Christianson continued following Jablonski in his squad car as she turned eastbound on the 2100 block of Hoffman Rd at a low speed. Jablonski then continued eastbound on Hoffman Rd at approximately 20 mph, in the eastbound lane. Jablonski then conducted a U-turn at the intersection of Hilltop Lane and Hoffman Road before stopping in the middle of the westbound lanes. At this point additional Officers arrived on scene and parked in front of the vehicle, effectively boxing it in. Officer Christianson parked his vehicle behind to prevent Jablonski from maneuvering or continuing to flee law enforcement.

Officers got Jablonski out of the vehicle and placed her under arrest. Prior to placing Jablonski in the squad car officers searched Jablonski's pockets. Located in Jablonski's front left pocket was a small plastic baggie containing a crystal-like substance. Officer Christianson recognized the substance to be consistent with narcotics/methamphetamine. The crystal-like rocks were entered into evidence and NIK tested positive for methamphetamine, weighing 1.09 grams.

Jablonski was driving up-and-down Hoffman Road within a protected drug enforcement school zone. Officer Christianson observed Jablonski driving within the protected drug enforcement school zone. Witness 1 and Witness 2 also reported Jablonski driving on Hoffman Road near Mankato East High School, which is located within the drug enforcement school zone.

Due to her admission of narcotics use, Jablonski was transported to MCHS Mankato. Due to her admissions of recent narcotics use and observed indicators of impairment, Officers applied for and were granted a search warrant for Jablonski's blood or urine, as it was suspected that she had been under the influence of narcotics while operating a motor vehicle.

Officers Honetschlager and Herwig attempted to serve the search warrant on Jablonski. Officer Herwig gave Jablonski a copy of the search warrant and explained that Jablonski was under arrest and that refusal to provide a sample per the terms of the search warrant was a crime. Jablonski refused to provide a blood or urine sample. Officer Honetschlager also attempted to explain the search warrant and refusal advisory to Jablonski. Jablonski continued to refuse to provide a sample.

Due to her level of intoxication Jablonski is currently located at the New Ulm Detox Facility. Therefore, a Complaint Warrant is requested.

SIGNATURES AND APPROVALS

Complainant requests that Defendant, subject to bail or conditions of release, be:
(1) arrested or that other lawful steps be taken to obtain Defendant's appearance in court; or
(2) detained, if already in custody, pending further proceedings; and that said Defendant otherwise be dealt with according to law.
